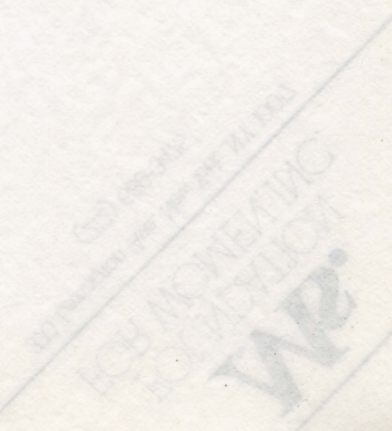


Sum Up of Meeting

We understand from our meeting with Toro Hirose and Kitty Shores on October 30 that the nature of the hearing in New York is to be different from the hearings that have been held so far. We understand the basic difference is that the Commissioners wish to have more time for dialogue and exchange with the testifiers and have therefore limited the number of testifiers to 25 to facilitate this process.
