

KENJIN KAI (Prefectural Clubs)

The people of Japan have always emphasized the place of origin of one's family. It should not be surprising, therefore, that among Japanese immigrants the kenjin (prefectural associations) such as the Hiroshima, Okayama, Yamaguchi, Fukuikei, and Kagoshima Kenjinsei had great significance. The kenjin (prefectural associations) helped each other immigrants to America, get started in employment or business, introduced newcomers into social circles, helped each other in adversity, celebrated births and weddings together, and reunited together. The Japanese group shown here was one of the smaller units, but their behavior was typical of ken groups. Around 1906 pioneers among them acquired undeveloped land in Pontiac today. Wardenware and Sand Stone, both of LaSallehurst and brought other kenjin to the area. They helped each other clear the land, build homes, and start a church. In many respects the ken group was seen as like an extension of the family.
