truly pay, or cause to be paid, promptly, unto the said President and Fellows of Har-
vard College, or such person or persons as that Corporation shall appoint to receive the
same, the whole of such sum or sums of money as shall become due to the said Presi-
dent and Fellows from [2] *Gentaro Takahashi* *now of Boston Mass and*
native of the town of *Iwashima* in the County of *Agatsuma*
