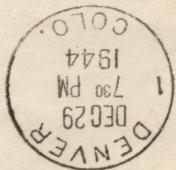


My dear Waka:
