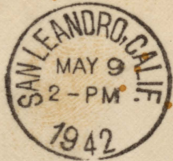

Ann O'Connell is getting married on May 23rd which is on a Saturday. It will be in the morning so I doubt very much whether we will be able to attend.

Edith Musser is getting married tomorrow at 11 o'clock. She left yesterday but plans to return to work. So you can see we are having plenty of excitement.
