Dearest Yoni:

Got up from my unorthodox bed -  
a sarongpat which I shared with  
Hideo Wada. We both slept with all our  
clothes on including shoes until 7 A.M.

Had breakfast of 2 eggs, 2 French  
fried bread, 2 bacon and 2 cups of  
coffee.

Went out to the field around  
10 A.M., checked our names in and  
got a belt equipped with two large  
hooks, a pair which empty potato sacks  
were hooked, and with two small  
hooks in the front. The idea is  
to let the potato sack drop on  
the ground and straddle it -  
pulling it as we fill the sack to  
about  $\frac{1}{3}$  full - 40 lbs.

Weather wasn't bad. We lunched

on three sandwiches, tea and an  
apple cake - out in the field. It  
wasn't much - we were starved.  
I got so hungry that I began  
to feel pretty bad in the stomach  
toward the end of the day.

Got through around 6 PM  
and I felt so bad by then that  
I had to vomit. Felt a lot better.

Had a hearty dinner of  
spuds, collage, tomatoes and rice.

Tonight, the four of us were  
each provided with tick mattress  
9' in sleeping on the floor in the  
hallway. George Jurji and  
Viktor are sharing a room - also  
sleeping on the floor.

The other boys are all fortunately

provided with heavy quarters and  
beds. We hope to move into a  
place when there is opening.

An suffering more or less from  
a sore back. The nurses here  
here says that we'll get used  
to the work in a couple of  
weeks - so there is something  
to look forward to.

The potatoes were we picking  
are for seed purpose. Consequently  
they are rather small and  
numerous.

There are red and white  
Irish potatoes.

More about them later  
all well.

Hope you are schedule in  
working.

Climate same as in Amara.

Breezy cold in the morning and  
warmer in the later part of the  
day.

Fine

Clear.

No. 93 is the address of the  
boarding house where I am  
staying.

The post office is just across  
the street.
