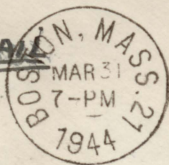

Dearest Yuri,

There isn't much to say just now. Am waiting for things to happen. Wrote a few thank-you letters to people who are working on my behalf in Providence.

Met Mr. Clapp a couple of days ago. Just for fun I said, "How about one of these domestic work - they pay me pretty good." \$25⁰⁰ to \$35⁰⁰ a week, room and board - if one has a good home. And he said, "Oh no." "We're going to put you in a factory."

Mr. Harris is absent - for duration. The navy got him on the 22nd. Now Mr. Clapp is looking for a man to take his place. I don't know who is going to answer your letter - maybe, Miss Reynolds.

Miss Reynolds went to Connecticut

to investigate a job prospect. Mr Dopp
left yesterday to look into another one
in conn. too.

Honey, I haven't said anything
to my folks about my progress of
work. They'd worry and would jump
to conclusions too easily. I did say
that I'm alright and fine, which
is true.

Today's paper came out with the
proposal about drafting 4 Fi. It may
affect me. Incidentally, the Dr. who
examined me at Washburn said that
my leg would probably put me in that
class.

Wrote a couple of weeks ago to Shiro
to ask what he tho't about the Washburn
proposition. Since then it fizzled but he
hadn't answered my letter - is he
around? Just let it go, honey. I guess
he wasn't too interested anyway.

And Joh. How is she? Long neglected
to ask after her health. With all of us

living under the war nerve and
camp nerve, it would be so easy to
yield to the physical and anxiety
as to how Tomar is doing at
Grand Junction doesn't help recovery
either.

Did I mention about a fellow who
is married and was going for his
physical? He was taken. He's quitting
his work (warehouseman) \$5⁺ an hour
40 hours a week and his wife - working
as stenographer in the same firm is
leaving to live with her sister. It
is a good job for a couple. The room
is here too where I'm staying. If
you know of anybody who would be
interested —. I wish I were — on our
behalf.

Spring is coming here. It's raining one
day and dry and warm the next. It
won't be long before the grass is green
and the trees will be green with fresh

leaves. See, darling, there are a lot of
beautiful places here about where
we can go hiking or picnicking.
