By direction of the Board of Education, two copies of this card, which contains the laws of the State of California and the rules of the Oakland Board of Education relative to school fraternities sororities or clubs, are being sent you. On entering the high school each student will be required to present one copy to the principal with his signature attached to the pledge to be found on page two. You will please keep the other copy for future reference.

No pupil will be admitted to any Oakland high school without signing this pledge. The Board of Education earnestly urges you to cooperate to prevent any violation of its rules pertaining to fraternities and to subscribe to the statement following the pupil's pledge.

STATE LAWS

"An Act to prevent the formation and prohibit the existence of secret, oath bound fraternities in the public schools." (Approved Mar. 13, 1909.)

The People of the State of California, represented in Senate and Assembly, do enact as follows:

Section 1. From and after the passage of this act, it shall be unlawful for any pupil, enrolled as such in any elementary or secondary school of this State, to join or become a member of any secret fraternity, sorority or club, wholly or partly formed from the membership of pupils attending such public schools, or to take part in the organization or formation of any such fraternity, sorority or secret club; provided, that nothing in this section shall be construed to prevent any one subject to the provisions of the section from joining the order of the Native Sons of the Golden West, Native Daughters of the Golden West, Foresters of America or other kindred organizations not directly associated with the public schools of the state.

Section 2. Boards of school trustees and boards of education shall have full power and authority to enforce the provisions of this act and to make and enforce all rules and regulations needful for the government and discipline of the schools under their charge. They are hereby required to enforce provisions of this act by suspending, or, if necessary, expelling a pupil in any elementary or secondary school who refuses or neglects to obey any or all such rules or regulations.

RULES OF THE BOARD OF EDUCATION

First: A recommendation for admission to any university or college or higher school will be denied to any pupil whose conduct in any way has been such as to give the principal reason to believe that the State law or any of the rules of the Board of Education in reference to secret fraternities, sororities, or clubs have been violated.

Second: Before any pupil can be enrolled in an Oakland high school, he must sign the following:

"I do not now belong to, nor am I pledged to become a member of, any secret fraternity, sorority, or club, composed wholly or partly of high school students, and I promise that during my entire high school course that I will not become a member of, nor will I pledge myself to become a member of, nor will I be in any way connected with, any secret fraternity, sorority, or club, composed wholly or partly of high school students."

Any pupil who violates the foregoing pledge shall be subject to suspension or expulsion.

Third: When transferring to another secondary or high school, a pupil who has violated the State laws or any rule of the Oakland Board of Education relative to secret fraternities, sororities, or clubs, the principal or teacher shall state upon the transfer that the right of recommendation to any university or college or high school has been forfeited.
