I blame myself for bringing up about the price of education etc. but she - well I guess she's just been home too long. In the evening the same spirit prevailed. I did many odds & ends. Clean, clear, etc. Then I actually became about done. We got a new big heater. Sheridan is going into a convent. Wak surely feels mean.

Sunday, January 4, 1931

I didn't wake up any too early. Regular morning routine. After returning from cemetery, fixed my slip & some of my gym things. Kaeck & Kasou came over. Wak is going back to-morrow. I surely do pity her in a way. She wants to go but she has come to the stage of "I don't know", & it is sometimes hard for her with Tok to consider but she does hurt her a lot at times too. I pity & yet don't. She thinks a great deal about the cost of education too. Did not get to bed until 11:30.

Monday, January 5, 1931

It is certainly a splendid way to start the new term. Left home about 7:30 altho' up about 6:30. Our major has some more new kids. Program as follows: - Eng. ^{1. Pitty} VIII; study; ^{2.} Physics, ^{3. Russell} gym; ^{4.} U. S. II - ^{5.} Hilton & ^{6.} Jupp. II - ^{7.} Opera. Not such a bad one but plenty of work even tonight. Went to town & bought another sweater in return etc. Went to G. R. meeting. Not so hot. Train home. Talk about staying up, went to bed about 12 o'clock, a comp. in Eng got me. A boy that 500 word comp we started in there today. Dear old Percy! And thus the first day gone. Gym bunch O.K.

I went in bath & accidently put my watch in the water. Water got into it & I hope that it does not ruin it. Opened it out & wiped it off & going to sleep. 11:00

fair & warm. Sunday, July 26, 1931

Left until 9 o'clock this A.M.
To S.S. as usual. Looked at
papers. Lunch! We got
through the dishes about 12:50.
After sitting around a bit,
we walked to the cemetery.
Nick gave us a lift about
from B3rd home. Went over to
Ethel's. Looked at some
magazines. Phoned up
Anna in P.M.². Wrote a letter
to Vel. Wak had kind of a
grouch in P.M.². for lack
of sleep & cause Em had
been so noisy.

fair & cool ^{in P.M.} Monday, July 27, 1931

Dishes, a little sewing, & then cooked some rice for the first time. O.K. Sewed in P.M. Off & on. Had more trouble with my slip. Sat around after dishes & then started to read a book "Larry". Very good & I like it immensely. The frank expression of a young college boy through his diary, letters, & themes. His true thoughts. It is marvelous altho' it is a boy's thoughts.

Tuesday, July 28, 1931

cool & cold in evening. No sun - dull.

Slept until 8:30 this a.m. Got a letter from Vel & my pictures from S. F. Did a little sewing & then went to 73rd. Cooked again this a.m. - Rice, corn, & egg plant. On the spur of the moment, Em wanted to make a dress. So Tok went to get some material at 73rd with her. In the meantime I read a few more pages in "Larry" & sewed. Cause of Tok's wanting to separate fruits from Nagasawa, I had to help Em cut dress out. The way Tok was laughing later annoyed me greatly. From 5-6 I sat around with Kan in cellar. In the evening I wrote letters & sent out the pictures. 11:00

Wednesday, July 29, 1931
cool - later, sun.

Sewed a little then cooked. I did some sewing & reading in P.M. I went to play tennis with Dorothy. She stayed for supper. Then we talked. Was outside for awhile with Nick & Wak. Finished the book Larry by really himself. It is marvelous & love the boy for I wish that Han would learn something from it. Dorothy left about 10:30 having talked quite awhile with Han who dumped her at 14th without even waiting for cars. Just kiddish in those ways! Did a little exercise & then to bed.

Thursday, July 30, 1931

dull - fair later.

Was going to sew in A.M. but had to look after the beans & so could not. Wak & Tak went outside to pick asthers. Cooked. Got dressed ^{by} lunch to go to the dentist. ^{My} ~~My~~ ^{mom} got me sore! One of those times she gets on my nerves. To dentist! Bummed around in town after in a half day. Stopped to talk with Ruth for a while. I am through, I think with the dentist. Sat around after supper & read. Cleared my shopping of the day. We don't know whether we're going tomorrow or not.

bringing son with us. I wanted to go up & front of boat. Wak came but ~~Em~~ ^{Em} too & she insisted upon sitting at the side! she got me peeved! Oh! yes! ~~she~~ asked me if I passed the subject. I had to answer & wak naturally found out. Gosh! she made me mad for a while for that.

cool.

Friday, July 31, 1931

Woke up with "It." Felt kind of goggy in A.M. but was O.K. the rest of the day. Em decided that she was going today to S. F. She certainly meant business, she told Wak to change with Tok & cook in the A.M. & let her cook in the P.M. What a predicament! Wak did not care to go for she wanted to stay home to sew; Tok wanted to go; and Em wanted Wak to go. I had to go! So! So! Sat in the sun part of the morning (10:30^{sun} came out).

We took until 2 o'clock to get dressed & then to S. F. Em was all right & quiet all the time. Lilly-like when over there. Baby is getting bigger. Played Mah Jong - ate candy with coal; talked; had Chinese noodles then for supper & then we came home, (the

Saturday, August 1, 1931

dull & coolish in a.m. - sun out in P.M.

House work in a.m. Didn't clean room very clean. Talked with son & Wak. Cooked in a.m. & then washed my hair in P.M. since the sun came out altho' I had it. Washed the combs, which took some time. I suppose that I did not do much the rest of the day for I cannot recall any incidents. Read the newspaper. Well, Wak is sleeping with us tonite. Son & Nish went to Yunc's for Yoshi's farewell. Son brought up the fact that I might go to Merritt for awhile & take up more typ-ing, shorthand, etc. I would like to be a stenographer but Cal. would be better for me now. Mills? No - Financial. Oh! Gosh! I don't know what to do!!! I wish that I had someone to confide in.

Sunday, August 2, 1931

Clear. ~ sun out later

Rest a story in bed before getting up. Then to S.S. Brought my Asilomar pictures. After S.S., we had a meeting in which we decided to go Big Basin two weeks from yesterday. Wak did not want any help (groceries) so I read. Went to the cemetery & to Ethel's for a short time. Later went for a walk around the nursery with Son & Em. Sat around & talked in the evening. ^{Went to S. L.} get paper

Oh! gosh! I don't know what to do. Now, Merritt is in question too. If I had taken another course or rather if I had not graduated as I did, I wouldn't mind. Mill, I think, is out of question. Hoping to go to Cal. Son invited Yoshie & Kob. & Toki & wife

Monday, August 3, 1931

fair & cool.

After eating my 3 toast breakfast, I went over to Ethel's to tell her that I was not going to town today. I dressed hurriedly to go to the beauty-shop to get a hair cut. Darned a pr. of socks, did some food shopping & went into the kitchen to cook with Wak. Scorched my rice for the first time today.

Sat around & then read a story in the Good Housekeeping. Wak & son went to town. I started to make a pr. of bras. & then went to help Kan 'til 5 with the lillies. Fed the animals & then sewed again. Supper, sewed, & my diary which I have neglected since Tuesday. Kan said today that he was more mature than the next oldest boy at the club. I see that he does not realize how young in things he is.

Tuesday, August 4, 1931
fair but rather cool in P.M.

Last night I went into Wak's bed at
12:20 when she fell asleep on me after 1 1/2 hrs.
We talked of numerous things. School!
Got a telephone call from Vel. saying that
she would be over in P.M. Started to
sew but had to help Em cut a dress out
& then helped Wak cook a little. Mr.
Nagasawa, Iriki, & Sasaki came - Had luncheon
Vel. came about 1:30. Talked on Dot & Hughes
marriage, Aioloma pictures, about U.C. & Me
it. We may go there. Serious too. It would
swell if we both go. Maybe one would
give me a job. We went to play tennis too
swell fun. She won 6-2; 6-4. Got home
about 5:30 - 6:00. She drove me home.
It was swell. Y!!! Then I helped Wak
get some things ready for dinner. I did
not eat with others but ate plenty of
pickles. My legs are tired from tennis
Mr. Kobayashi played the flute with
John's piano. It was really nice. We
talked & looked at art pictures. Mrs.
Domoto is very charming & cute in manner.
They left about 10:30 & then we did the dishes
Bed about 12:30. What an eventful day.

Wednesday, August 5, 1931

fair.

up at 8:15. Son & I did lots of washing in naphalene all morning. Did not have a chance to help Wak cook very much. Phoned to Merrit to get particulars. Son & I talked about cost of Mills, Cal, & Mex. I need much more money for clothes, & social if I go to Cal. If Del. comes - Merrit would be swell. —

Ironed one of my dresses & fixed the blue silk one in P.M. Did a "wee" bit sewing in P.M.². Wak pierced my big pimple under my nostril for me. A big $\frac{1}{2}$ came out but it hurt - tragi-comedy. Son took patunc's for a time too.

Nick is still going strong. Oh! yes! Tok raised a rumpus by wanting to go to the Happy-G-Lucky Dr. tomorrow too. So unconcerned, lazy-like is Tok yet simple.

Had a fine fight after bath (at) canie pod tried to feed it to Wak. Mussed bed so much she left with me tonight. Talked awhile oh! sigh!

Thursday, August 6, 1931

fair & warm

Did not know just how to fix my slips over again so wasted some valuable time. Cooked. Sewed and ironed & talked in P.M.². Tok & Son went to S.F. to see Yachi "off" for Japan. They come home with Nick. Une. gave them a Chinese lunch treat. I cleared things out after supper. Son brought up the topic of me going to school. Merit, U.C. or Mills. Mills was out of question for me a long time ago. After some minutes of thinking & talking, papa decided that he could afford my going to Cal. - That's that. Looked over the publications for Cal. Clothes! It is going to be different. I know. Off to bed soundly.

Friday, August 7, 1931

fair & warm.

Dishes, bed, talked, & cooked with Wak. She makes me feel so dumb at times but I cannot help it if I don't know how to cook as yet. On the spur of the moment I decided to go to town not necessarily for myself but for Wak. on 2:10 train. Could not find a sweater that I liked. Lost my gloves! Heck! Supper, dishes. I ripped my shirt & laid my pattern on but could not get a skirt & long-sleeve jacket out. I might go down town tomorrow to look at some sport jackets.

Wednesday, August 12, 1931

fair - warm P.M.

Got up about 5:30 o'clock. Claire called for me about 6:50. Registration wasn't bad but some was a little confusing. Jazy is my student advisor & I had my faculty. It's so funny about it too. Filing of cards, swearing ^{at} attorney etc. Made an appointment with Advisor for tomorrow. Walked around, talked with Mr. & Mrs. Gleiss. Had lunch at the Y. with Jazy & girls. Met Claire then. Went to the med. & physical ex. Med. O.K. but had to unclot for physical. Not so hot. Was too late to go to the colleges meeting. Went to the Y. tea. Home about 7:00 staved. Sat around & then planned program. Jaz. my major(?). Hist, Eng. & Ital. I put down a sis. as nervous break. & wished I hadn't. The end of the day tired. Too little for ^{to say} - 11:00

Thursday, August 13, 1931

fair.

Left about 8:00 for my 2nd day on the univ. campus. Went to the gym to change my class & then up to the infirmary to see if I could change the "why" Cal? in Service Health paper. Changed by luck. Finances to nurses. Am certainly glad. Up to my advisers. Met Claire & we went to meeting in Wheeler. Dot Black joined us. Speeches on campus life welcome. Had lunch at .35 at a good place. Rested at Stephens Union. Went to A. S. U. C. tea. Signed up for A. A. A. Claire & I came home together. Home about 6:00. Decided to take parish instead of Ital. Claire's suits went out there too. I now feel the difference. Yesterday I was inefficient & "peevish" a little to myself but I'm going to like it I'm sure.

Friday, August 14, 1931

fair & cool.

Woke up about 8:00. Called for Claire at 9. Went out together. Having at last decided to take Spanish, I went to my advisor to tell her of my change of language. Went to the Y. & signed up for G. K. & joined. Pres. Sproul spoke at the meeting. He certainly has power in his speech & is inspiring young too. We had lunch at a small place - Doc. Black, Claire & I. We went to the rally at Heart gymnasium. It was short but I waited with Grace so it became late. Jazy & I came home together. 5:30. Got ready to go to the Pres. & Mrs. Sproul's reception. Hostesses in even. gown. Yutik, Kich, & Tomi came after us to see Ty. It was pretty. Home about 10:00 & to bed. Kich hit a man today.

Saturday, August 15, 1931

fair & warm.

Did not wake up 'til 8:30.
Made my bed and went to Cal.
Met Dora Lee on the street
car. She visited Roosevelt &
was told by Mrs. Schutte that
I was attending U.C. She is
studying hard as usual. Signed
up for Spanish & English. Grace
& I went together. Got into
the English class that I wanted to.
Set around with Claire for awhile
but decided to have her phone me
to tell me if I've gotten into the
Spanish class that I wanted. The
result - unsatisfactory. Did some
shopping in town & home hungry.
Looked at the papers & read.
No sat. classes anyhow.

Claire went to the reception
so I feel better.

Sunday, August 16, 1931

fair

Nick woke us up about 8
& Wake & I got out of bed about 8:40
off to L.S. again. Nothing much
happened there. Looked at the
papers & lunch. Went to the
cemetery after lunch. We went to
see a tennis tournament at uncle
court. Pretty good players. Came
back for supper. After the dishes,
I got things ready for classes
on the morrow at 9 o'clock.

Wrote up my diary. The consolation
of my soul. I wished that
I had someone to talk with to
enlighten my worries.

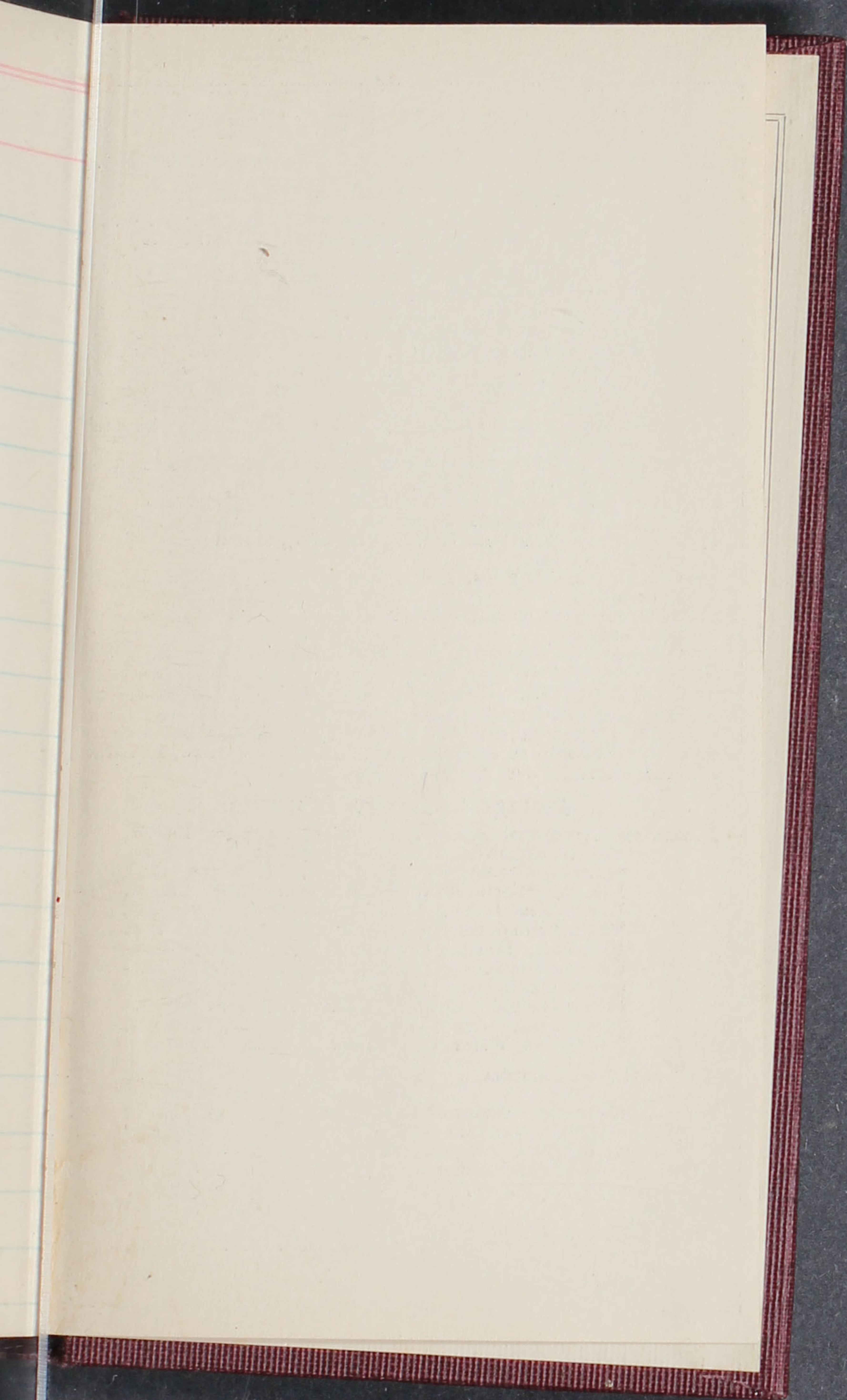
