Three cases were referred to me.

[REDACTED] Financially unable to pay for operation. Father not at all anxious to have operation performed.

[REDACTED] Able to pay from what they save from WRA wages. CC-14 completed. Family desires operation. Willing to cooperate.

[REDACTED] Decision regarding operation dependent upon the findings of doctors. If absolutely necessary, will write husband asking him amount family able to contribute if any.

This question enters my mind: Shall we set up separate folders on these cases as we already have on the other cases referred to the Crippled Children's Services.
