PUBLIC WELFARE COUNSELLING UNIT

Family Counselling, Helping Each Family Develop Long Term Plans for the Future Aiding Persons Referred to It By the Relocation Information Bureau, Keeping Required Files and Family Information

PROJECT RELOCATION OFFICE

Providing Employment Guidance, Information of Job Opportunities Providing Clearances, Official Communications, Hostel Apptmts. Aiding Referrals to Relocation Information Bureau

FIELD RELOCATION OFFICES

Aiding Persons Needing Help in Employment Guidance, Job Placement, Family Counselling, & Social Guidance

REPORTS OFFICE

Requests Needed Information, Receives and Distributes Information to, Relocation Information Bureau & Counselling and Advisory Personnel

EDUCATION SECTION

Provides and Trains Leaders & Instructors, Classrooms, & Teaching Aids Upon Request of the R.I.B.; Conducts High School Classes in Relocation

COMMUNITY ACTIVITIES SECTION

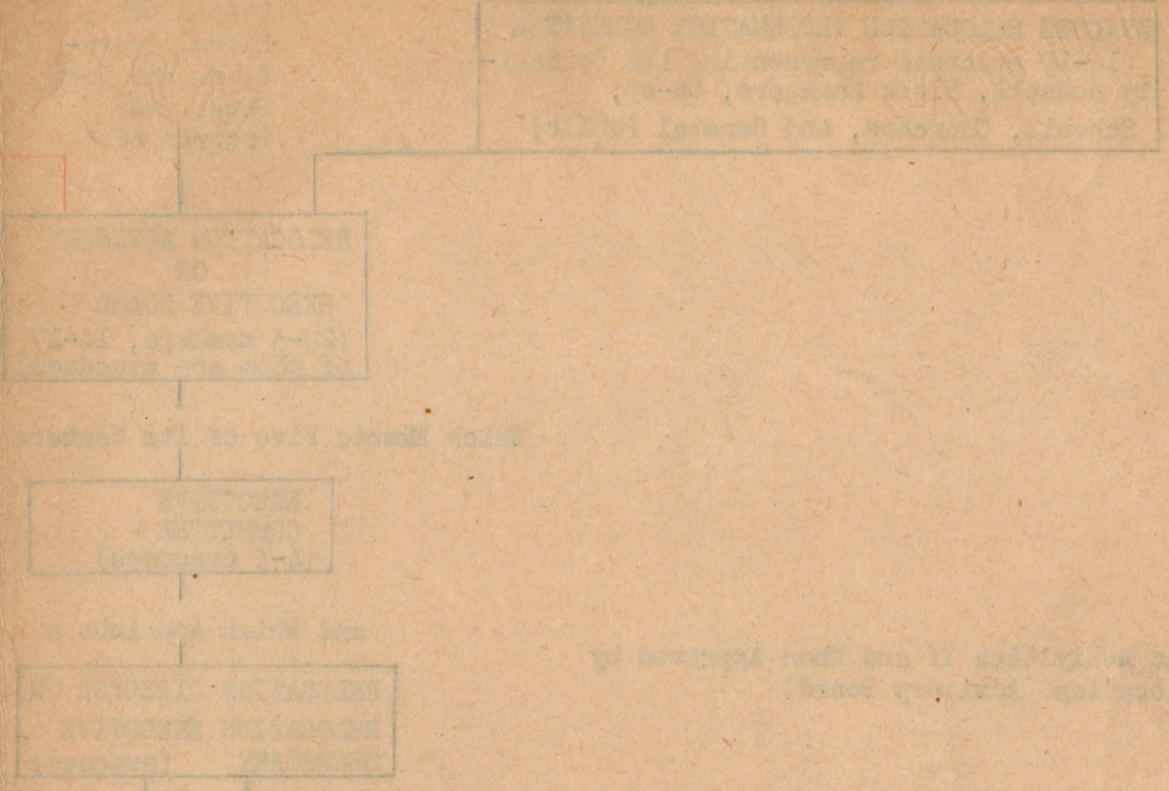
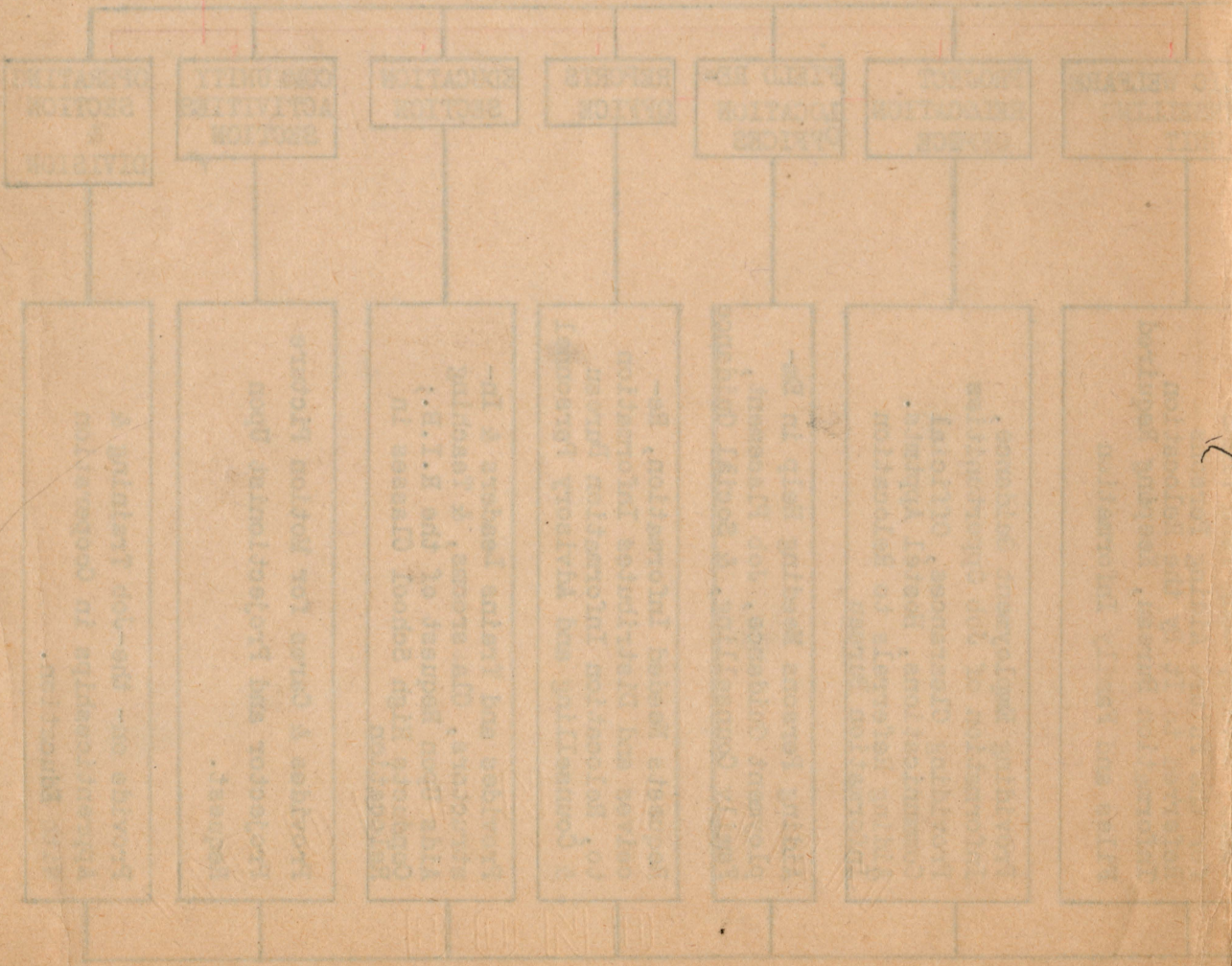
Provides & Cares for Motion Picture Projector and Projectionist Upon Request.
