vacant house. & Bldg.

Mr. Watanabe started  
his shop (Cleaning) cost him  
\$700.00 so far. and can't get  
what he wants. Has a business

of \$60<sup>00</sup> a week average.  
and working out on top of it  
he is doing good but I just  
wonder whether it is worth  
while to operate here in  
Denver. There are lots  
of jobs here. but the War  
manpower Commission comes  
around and pulls the guise  
out of non essential jobs  
as cleaning plant. Heard  
that one of the boy (fellows  
~~the~~ son that worked with me  
one day) has been pulled off  
of a job which he was getting  
\$55<sup>00</sup> a week. and getting 75¢  
hour, now in some stock yard.  
Think it is better for me to  
get out of Denver soon, before  
to get caught by W.M.C. Don't  
you think now don't get one

wrong because I am not  
saying this because I am  
alone some ~~how~~ I want to go  
back to you so soon.

I topped a few more dresses  
to day on my own time, you  
know I can do it. and do a  
better job than the help there  
but it take little more time  
than they do. Between you  
and me I think I can do  
\$50.00 worth a work a month.  
If it is just cleaning I am  
sure I can handle it. that  
is only \$20.00 a day. and that  
isn't much cleaning to finish  
if you have the right equip-  
ment. I would like to tackle  
that cleaning shop in Jail  
if I can get it with \$1000.00  
down payment. or even Rent

the place out right. I guess  
Denver is no place to start  
cleaning ~~plant~~ shop without  
a plant ~~not~~ money. Fellow  
have to have little capital  
to do any thing now days.  
and on top of it you are  
limited to certain district  
on the low class end of  
the town.

Wike was saying ~~that~~ <sup>she knows</sup>  
that she met a ~~guy~~ <sup>guy</sup> that  
came out of Tall-lake &  
her husband had a hard  
time to find a job. he  
is working for \$38<sup>00</sup> a week  
she told her that I will  
be going back to Idaho  
soon so she can have the  
job if he wants it after I  
leave. She is going to

call her in few days. I told  
 Mike if he wants my job  
 tell him to come and see  
 me so we can plan things  
 I like to give the job to the  
 guy she knows any way. When  
 I hear a tough <sup>luck</sup> story one had  
 I feel pretty lucky. I only played  
 one day. and that is all.

I finally got use to Denver  
 and gain my apetite but caught  
 a little cold too. It is because  
 I haven't got my ice box with  
 me this time. I think will  
 get over it in few days

Say do you know I spent  
 \$85<sup>00</sup> all ready since I left  
 Caldwell. that is not including  
 my fair \$35<sup>00</sup> so total expence

\$/20<sup>00</sup> and ~~you~~ earned 27<sup>50</sup>  
still got \$/25<sup>00</sup> because Pop  
said he didn't want the money  
and he got enough dough  
yet. So I didn't leave any  
better send it around ~~me~~  
when I start working again  
I am planning to stay in  
Idaho another year. Expense  
out this way will let me up  
I need the money now so  
I am not planning to relocate  
to Denver at all. Unless  
some thing happens.

well I guess I will close  
for to night
