

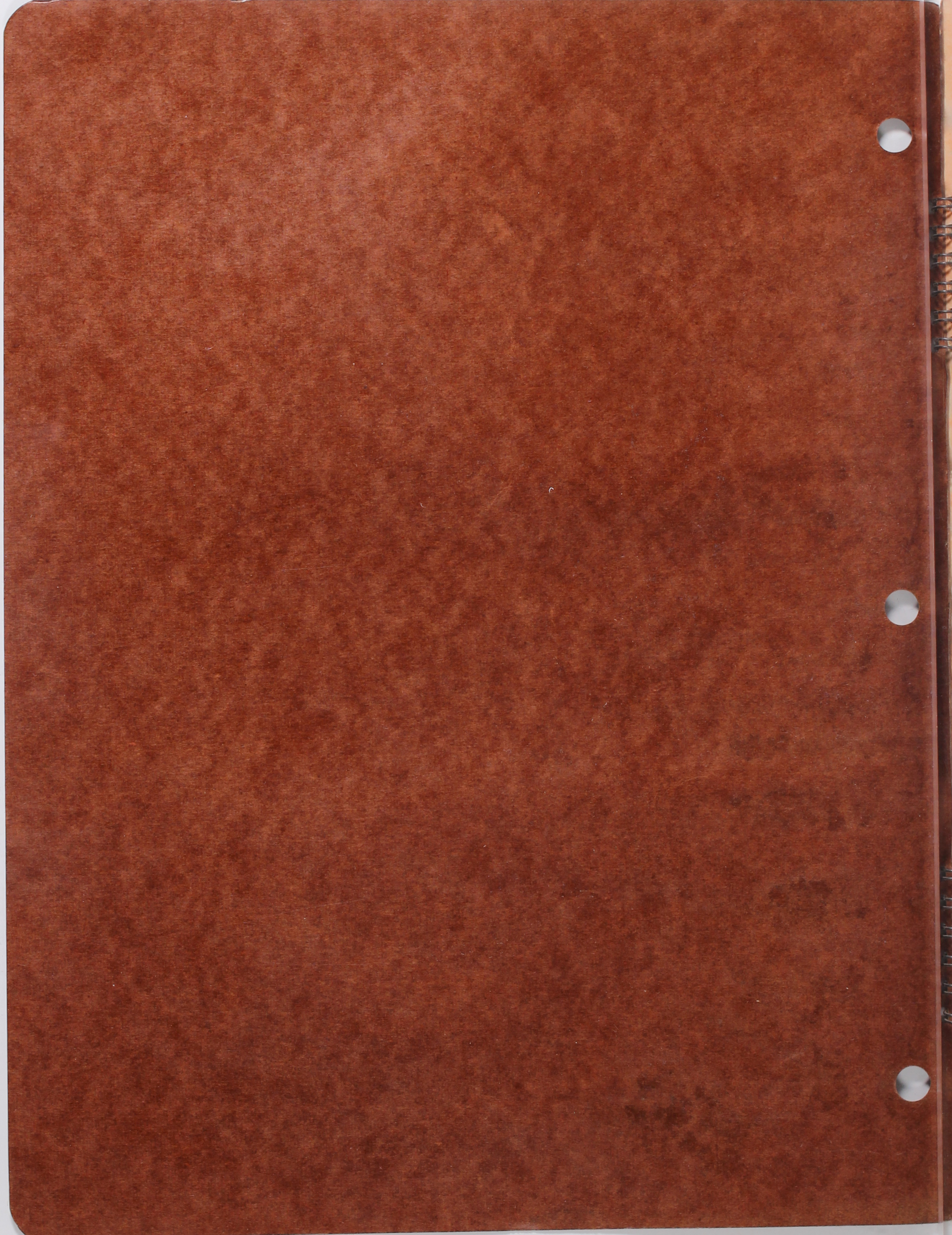

August 6, 1945 Monday clear

week is vacation from American  
school. The vacation, which is  
supposed to last one week, is  
a pleasure for me because I could  
catch up sleep.

August 8, 1945 Wednesday clear

Today about eight o'clock  
I started climbing the rock  
which is Castle Rock. It was  
about eight-thirty o'clock  
we left the camp from main  
gate. The way we climbed  
the mountain or rock was  
same as usual, the path.  
except we went to lava bed  
and saw some Indian writing.  
Terrain in which we traveled  
was rough, hilly, and stage-  
brush growing. The hills  
were like garden field of  
back home especially Rio Vista.

August 9, 1945 Thursday clear

This morning my father gave



holdy hell to some kids who took his tomatoes which he was raising. My father raise his temple to a degree that you boil could boil water and raise as if the consonants were going off.

August 11, 1945 Saturday clear

This afternoon I went to movie at Tri-State Theater. The movie was "In The Meantime Darling", starring Jennie Cain and etc. The movie was one of wartime kind - mushy mushy kind.

The war with Japan is final stage today. United States is sending ultimatum for the passed weeks. Two days ago United States' B-29, Bigger bomber, send on & drop atomic bomb on Hiroshima and Nagasaki; Japan maybe in a day or two the war will be over because of Russia entering the war against Japan and atomic bombing of Japan.



The situation we are in now is unpredictable. (family) since the ending of war is near.

Incidentally this morning I went to Japanese school to help clean the place or room up.

August 14, 1945 Tuesday clear

This afternoon four o'clock P.M. President Truman ~~announced~~ announced that Japan accepted the surrender term meaning that the ~~war~~ World War II is over.

The present question that confronts us where are we going and when or between the period of six and unknown months.

Tonight there was no school study in Japanese because of this incident.

August 15, 1945 Wednesday clear

Today is an official holiday this also applies for tomorrow too.

Two days before the surrender was accepted by Japan Soviet Republic entered the war against Japan. Soviet Forces immediately after declaring war invade Manchuko and the Island of Sakhalin.

August 16, 1945 Thursday clear

August 17, 1945 Friday clear

August 19, 1945 Sunday

Today the Japanese emissaries were at Manila, Philippines most likely discussing the terms of surrender.

August 25, 1945 Saturday clear

Today was practically same as yesterday except there was no school today, since today is holiday.

This afternoon anyway I went to movie, "Sunday Dinner for a Soldier" a dinner was chicken fried to a degree that my mouth would go watery. This morning we had at mess-hall pancakes the specialty of Tullo-Lake. Pancake was supposed to be delicious thing to eat, but every since the mess-hall start serving pancake every other day I could taste pancake in my dream. They also served eggs hard or easy boil or fried egg so when I come home I could make somebody else smell the egg I ate. For the lunch we always practically the same kind of food therefore we are always eating at home.



August 26, 1945 Sunday clear

Stanley, a Hawaiian born boy, came over today to talk. Boy is he anxious to get out of the camp and by the way he talks he will be out of this camp in "no time." Since he is about ~~fifteen~~ fourteen years old he surely have big dream like owning shop for instant maybe he will accomplish this dream.

Homework from both school keep me occupy doing it since I can't finish I think I catch hell or maybe lecture one hour. Blah! Blah! Blah! would teachers go lecturing to dumb student like me.

September 1, 1945 Saturday Windy.

This afternoon as usual I went to movie at Tri-States Theater. The movie was "For Whom the Bell Tolls" starring Gary Cooper and Ingrid Bergman. This story was based on the fact of Spanish civil war in the year 1937. In this <sup>war</sup> the German and Italian practice their art of war of following year by letting their army fight ~~with~~ Fascist Government of Spain. The loyalist or



Republican with the help of Russia's army made a desperate stand to overthrow Franco regime but no avail the Fascist won thus Franco government is still sovereigning the country.

Also this afternoon Japan officials surrender to United Nations. This was done on Tokyo Bay on U.S.S. Missouri.

Thus today is officially surrender of Japan and closing of World War II.

Sept. 15, 1945 Saturday Clear.

The movie that was shown today was "Bring on the Girls" starring Eddie Brackert, Veronica Lake, and Sonny Tuft. Some peason did appreciate the movie so I guess I enjoy the movie.

During the week my father came back from Ogden, Utah ~~that~~ <sup>on</sup> Thursday, to recruit some worker.
