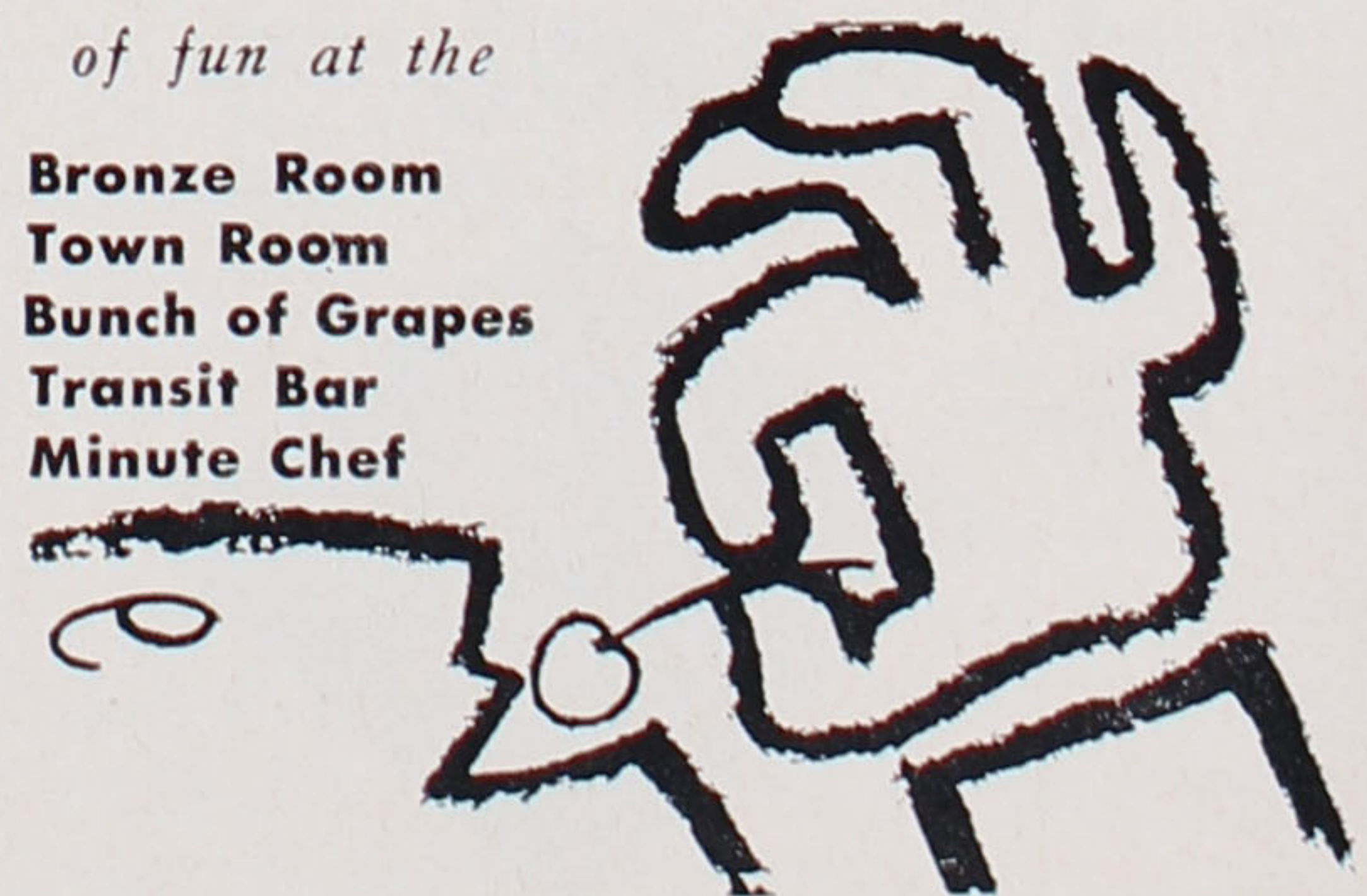

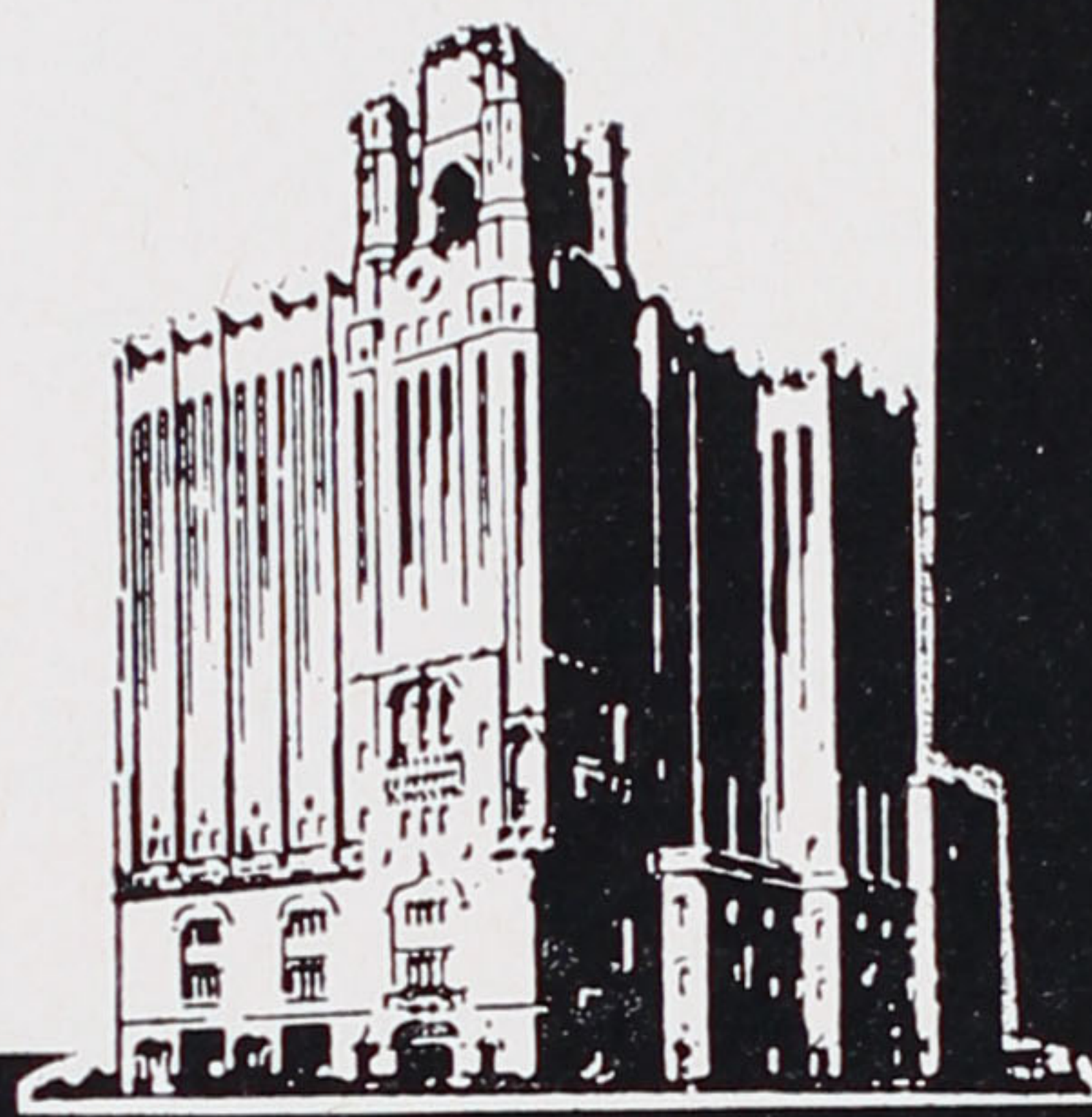

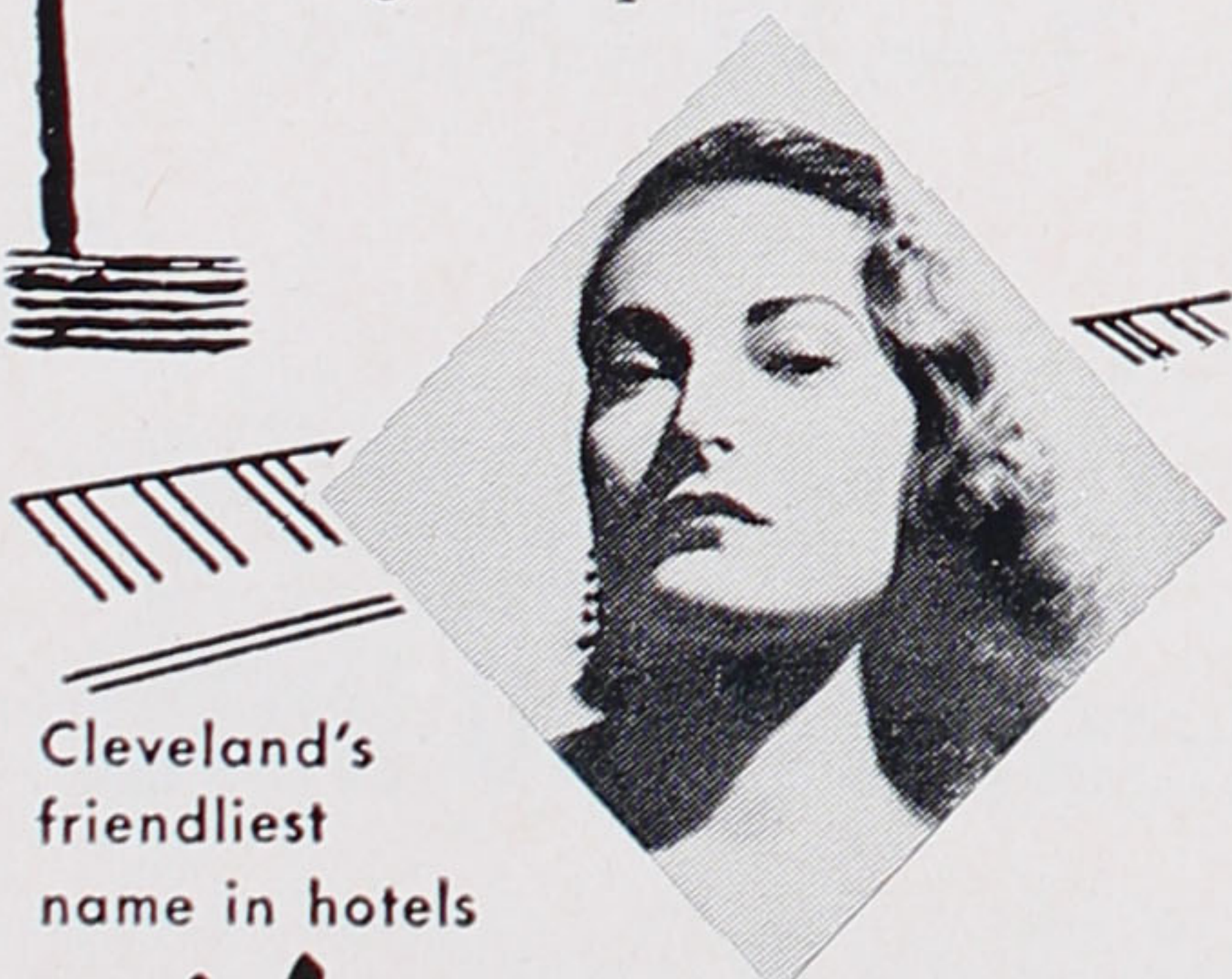

"The World of Suzie Wong"

Joshua Logan's production of the new Paul Osborn play, "The World of Suzie Wong," is probably one of the largest non-musical shows to hit the stage in recent years. The tender love story, taken from the best selling novel, will be seen at the Hanna Theatre for two weeks beginning Monday, February 22. Matinee performances will be given on Wednesdays and Saturdays.

Producer David Merrick has rounded up a cast of forty-one actors to inhabit the exotic Hong Kong settings, a cast comprising eleven different nationalities, speaking fourteen languages. They will act in replicas of the famed city of intrigue and romance fashioned by designer Jo Mielziner who has created the mood and scenery for the eleven scenes and two acts which is one of the eagerly awaited productions of the season.

"The World of Suzie Wong" is the love story of delightful and beautiful Suzie Wong, played by Jeri Miyazaki, and a brilliant young Canadian artist, played by Robert Elston. Both have to contend with two worlds — the one they would dream of having together and the one they must contend with in order to survive. Other principal players include Tom Helmore as a wealthy Hong Kong resident who loves Suzie and Chase Crosley as the American art dealer who vies for the artist's affections.

Erica Morini will celebrate her tenth appearance here as assisting artist with The Cleveland Orchestra, George Szell conducting, on Thursday and Saturday evenings, February 25 and 27, at 8:30 p.m. in Severance Hall.

Hailed by critics as "the leading woman violinist of our time," Miss Morini will be heard in the Beethoven Concerto.

The 18th program will include two contemporary compositions: the Orchestra will give the first American performance of the Fifth Symphony by Laszlo Lajtha, a major work by an outstanding Hungarian composer, and will present "Symphonic Metamorphoses on Themes of Weber" by Paul Hindemuth, a piece now firmly established in the international repertoire even though it was premiered just 18 years ago.

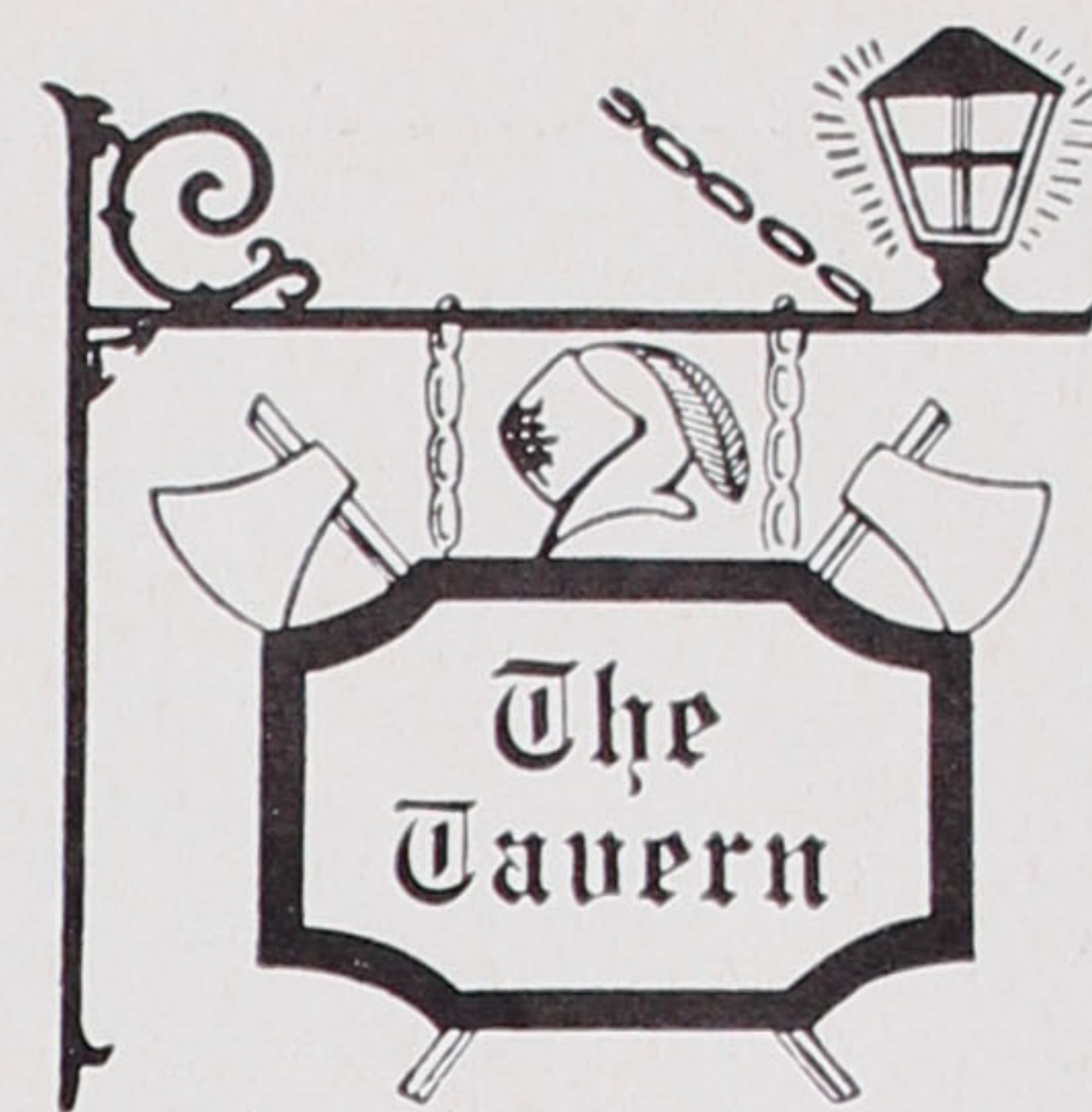

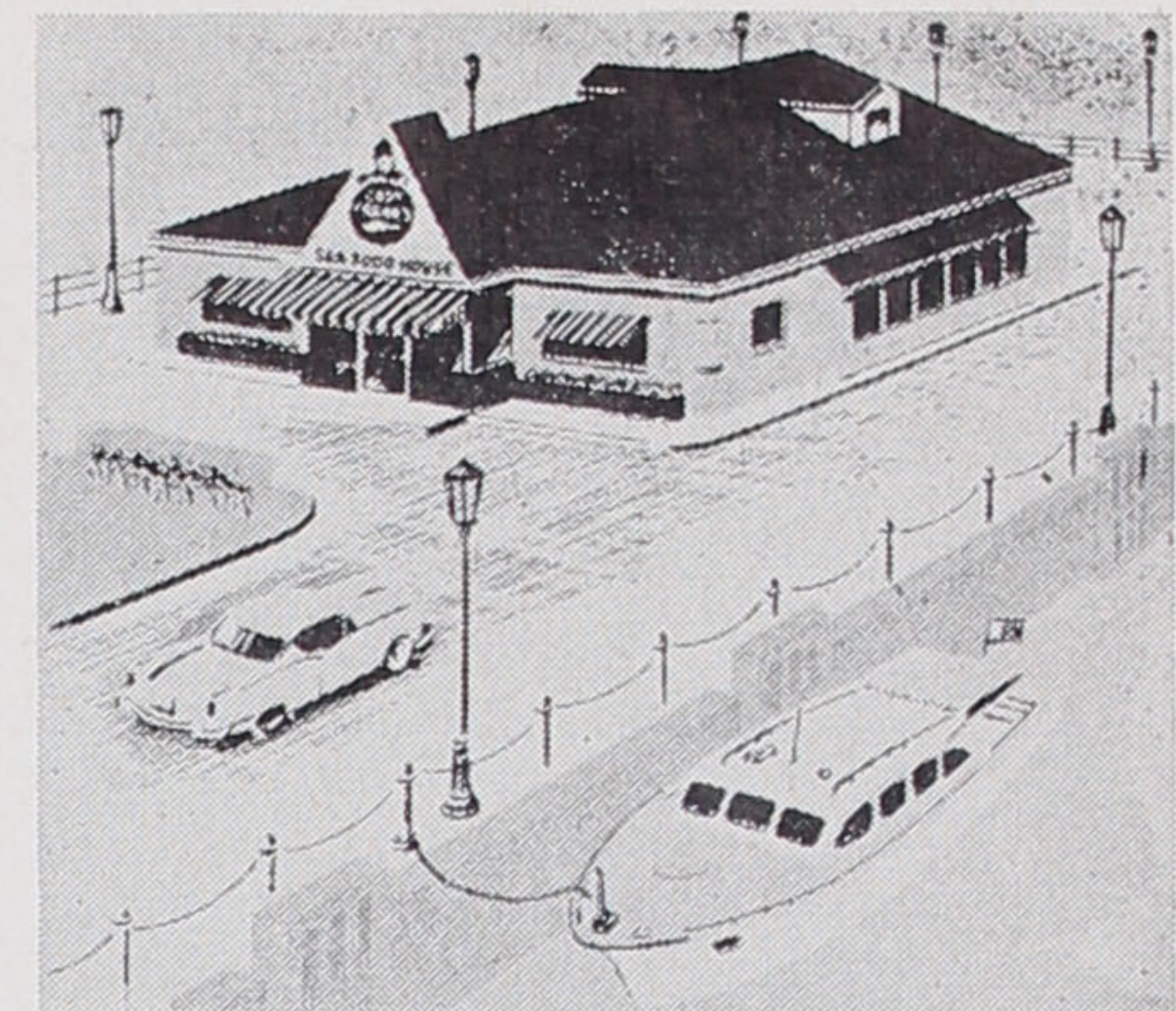

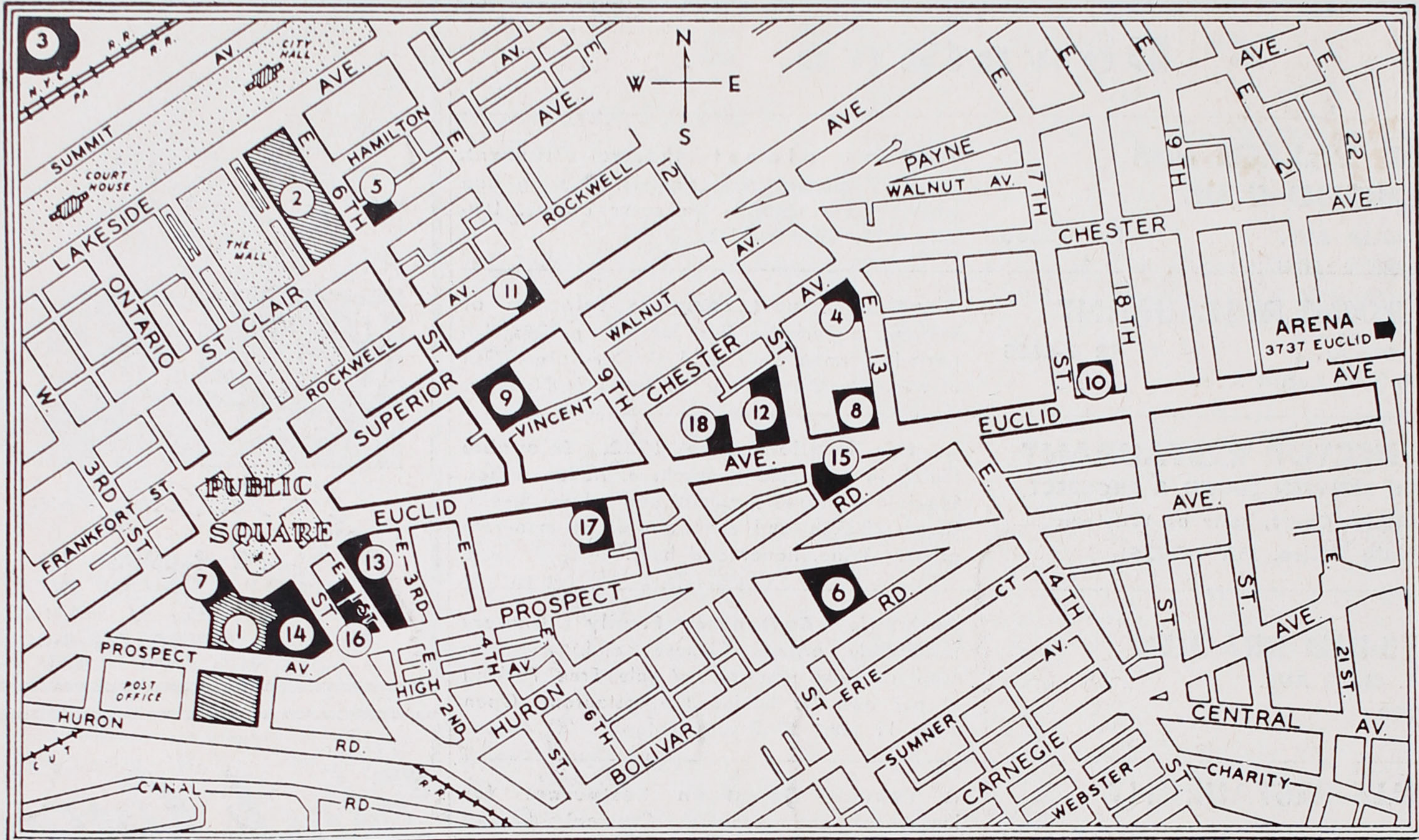
