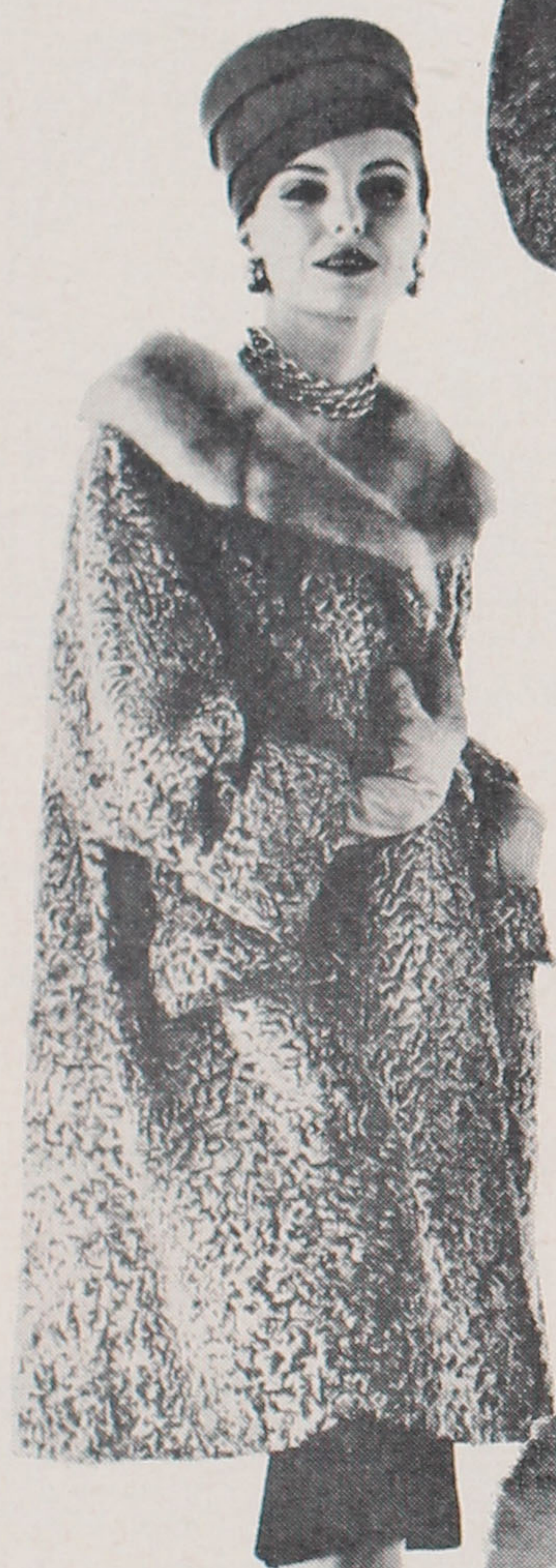
Autumn Haze is Rudi Gernreich's favorite mink mutation for a striking short coat with free, straight lines that roll into a flattering frame at the throat.

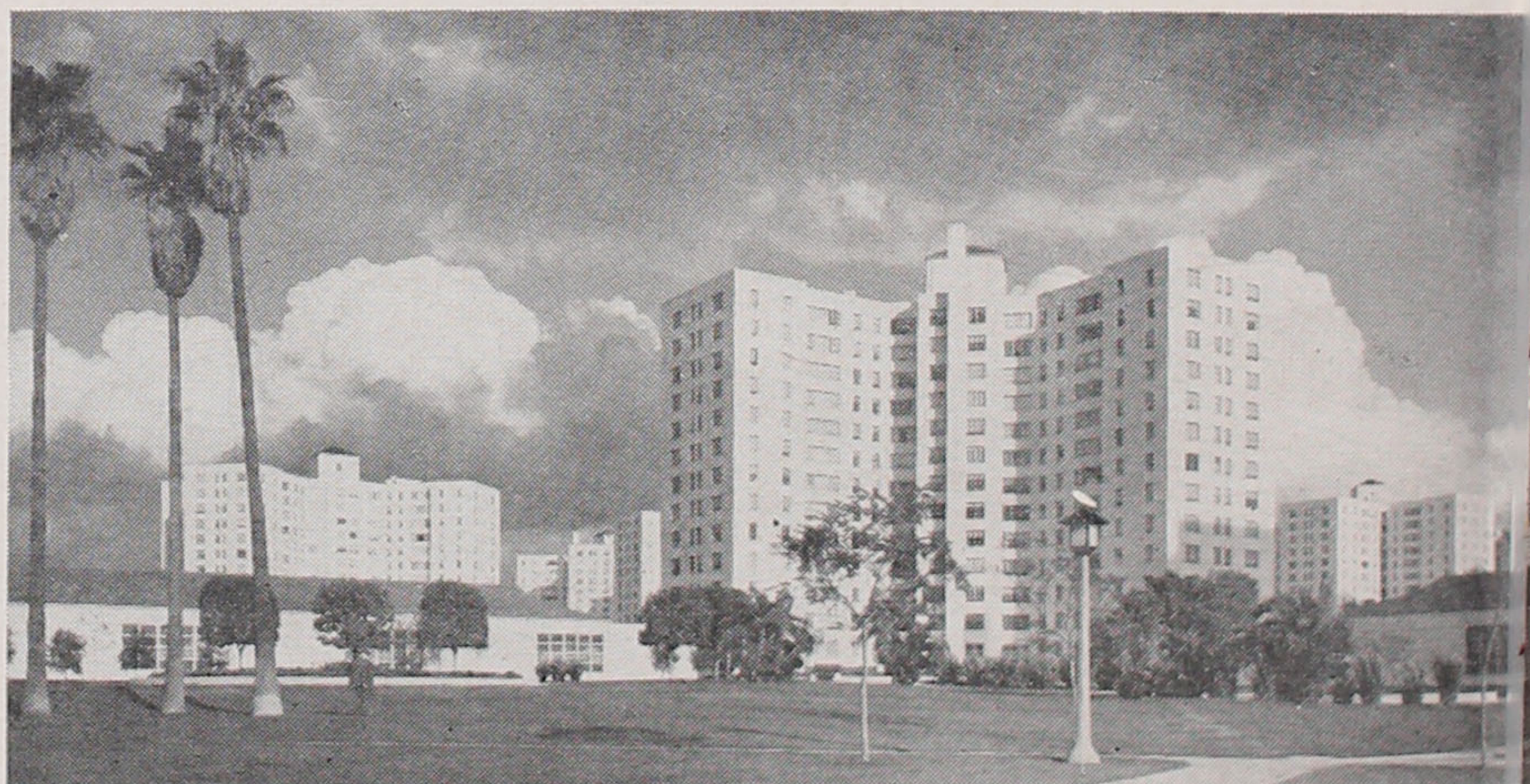



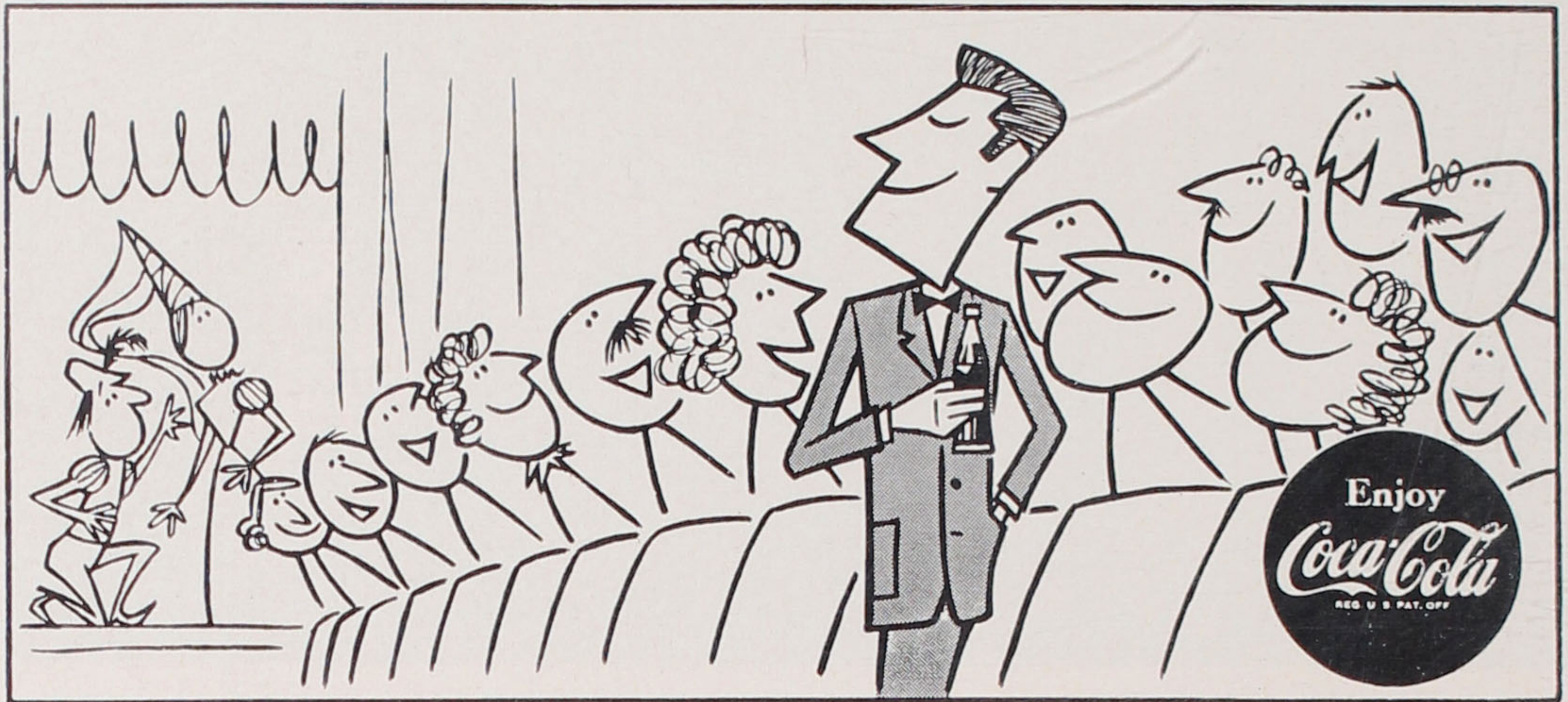

Can a woman make a good Martini?

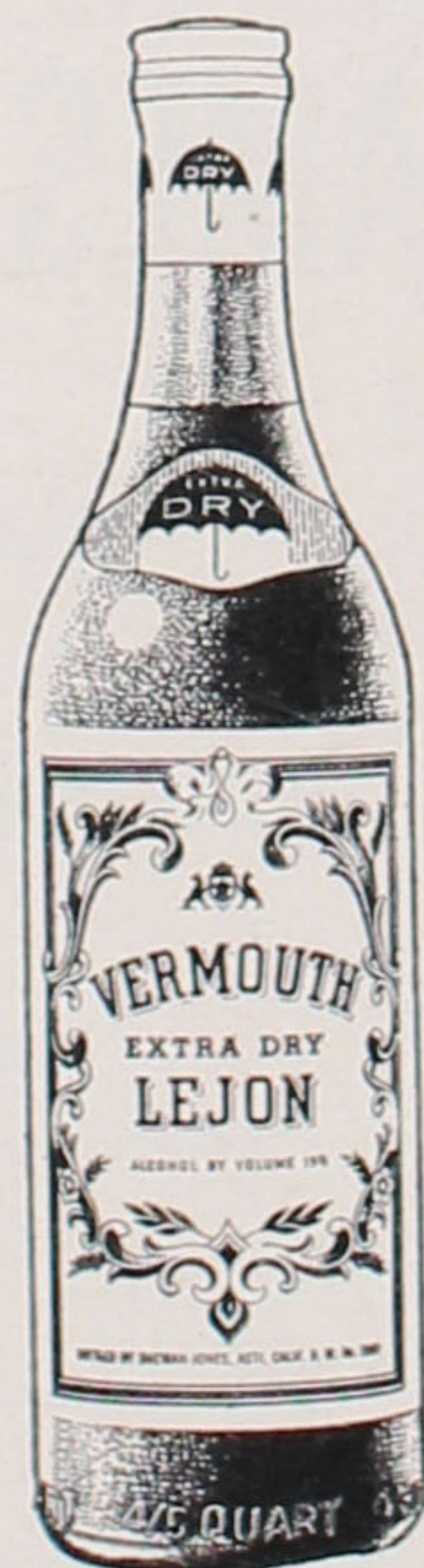
