Also write and let me know what languages you sing in, as personally I think we can work out something that would be tremendous for your future career.


I went to the "Folies Bergere" in Paris and they were still using Ruby Richards name - it seems there must be another girl working under her name.

Received your letter with newspaper ads and programs, thanks for same.



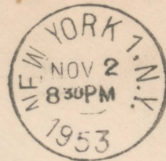
