

Friday night
April 27, 1945

Dear Bill: —

I just found out that you are now in Italy again. It was a surprise when I was walking down the street about 4 blocks away from where I live & I bumped into Sami Washino. It was really a big surprise to find her here. She's walking in an millinery shop close by. How have you been? You must be awfully busy again — Do you see Eddie?

Did I tell you that I was working
at the "Curator Workshop" a
Physical & Occupational Therapy
under the Community Health Center.

They keep me quite busy &
today I had to go down to
the Central Station & in the
afternoon to the North Station to
work. I haven't seen a nurse
for months & today just
when I thought I'd meet me
at the North Station she happens
to be sick.

I'm sorry I didn't write — please
forgive me — have you heard
from David yet? He says

his platoon has 17 Japanese.

It's supposed to be the best

platoon & he finds the fellows
pretty nice,

I'm going down to see mom

& Pop around May 17th. See!

It'll be good to see them.

Gosh! Am I homesick for

our family — The way I

feel now, I sure wish we
had one small grocery store

↓ just be together. Lots of people
are going back to California —
When I go down to see mom &
dad I'm going to see what
they want to do — Jim's sister
Lumi wants to relocate but I
don't know whether she should
come out here. I'd love to
have her here, but Jim says
he wouldn't be here long
so maybe it's best for her to
stay with her folks, I'd certainly
like her to be with me, though,
after he leaves.

Tomorrow night, ~~Oh~~ I'm going to
Ben Fuentes' home about 7 blocks
from here. His wife, Masako,
invited Oshu & I. It'll be the
1st time I'll ~~get~~ see her since
she left camp & it'll be
so good to see her. It seems
ages since I've seen any of my
friends. Most of my time is
spent with Hakuji & I'm
getting awfully lonesome for
Japan again.

The other night the Director of our
shop invited us over her home.

Miss Schri (That's her name) is really
nice — she's clear-cut + English
+ we all like her so much
there are only 8 of us there
+ so we're like one family.

Tomorrow I'll send you one
of the pamphlets we put out.

I sent one net to mom last

I don't know whether she's
received it. Haven't heard from
them for awhile + I feel
that they are busy. I hope the

work isn't too hard. When I go
down I'm going to ask the
Donnelly's what they're doing.
Since Mrs Donnelly's come back I
haven't heard from them, but
David said when he visits
them they like the place. Still
I'm kind of worried. Oh yes! Bill
thinks a lot for the perfumes
from France & the snapshot.

Moto said he got his too.

It's getting a little warmer
up here in Minneapolis but
it still is chilly, but the

afternoon are nice. (Before I
forget, I received your eyeglasses
too from France) I'll keep them
for you. Well, I must close
cause I have my desks to
do. Please take care of yourself.
If there's anything you want
write + tell me.
