Dear Bill,

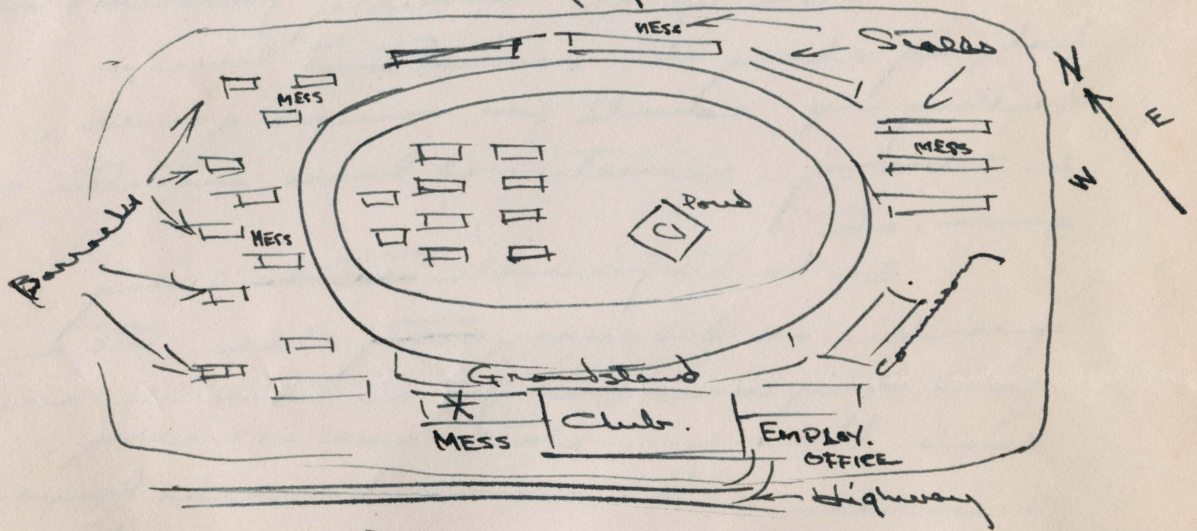
