Corporal Sino, what's the
orders for today. Oh--
please don't make me do
that. I'll do any thing else
besides that. I'll even
press your pants, shine
your shoes and brush
off your coat. A bargain,
thanks Corporal.

Well how's things
going along, high and mighty.
Don't get too bossy or the
bucks won't take you.
Remember you used to be

one.

Heard Akira also got
a raise to supply sargeant
or was it you that told me
that. Also heard Beef
Muramoto is a sargeant
too. Boy, you Bay Regiment
are sure getting up there.

What you going to do
with all that money you
are pulling in? Save a
little of it for the future
Bill. You will sure need
it then. What percentage
goes into Taxes. Heard
it was pretty high now even
for soldiers.

The army is going to
take over the camp to
ask for volunteers for

a segregated ³ combat corps.
On the whole I don't
think the camp likes
the idea of having us
Japanses segregated into
to one corps. They are
having a mass meeting
tonight to clarify the
facts and issues
concerning volunteering and
drafting. Guess I'll go
there tonight and see
if I can put in my two
cents worth.

I'm planning to go to
B. U. this coming March
24th for the spring semester.
I think I'll first work
for a couple of months

though. Too late to
enter BYU now. Winter
semester started January
4th - 1943.

Just ~~took~~ a couple
hours off to go eat and
go to a meeting I mention
before in this letter. It
seems there are quite
a few who have grievances
to put up before they will
volunteer. \$ This talk
about segregating Japanese
doesn't sound so hot to
me. If I go in I want
to be able to mix in with
the caucasian soldiers.

Glad to hear you had
a swell New Year Eve in
Robert Rel. Center. Give

able to dance with a fellow
in a uniform. lucky you.

I didn't do so bad my-
self. Shizu came home
the afternoon of the eve
and we both went to the
dance. Couldn't fool around
much, but we did have some
fun. Shizu is back in
Ogden waiting to go to
school in the fall.

What made you go
over Tokio Inuyasi's apt.
in Rohwer? Didn't know
you got to know her
so well. Give her my
regards if you see her
again. Also to the rest

of the de Stockton gang
You didn't mention Mary
Okanator's name. Isn't she
in Rohwan like the rest
of the gang?

Sum dustier than
h. - tonight. Could hardly
see anything in the
dark as I walked home
from the meeting. Sounds
like it calmed down now.
That's one thing that is
awfully summarizing.

I told Shura to drop
you a line if she had
time. Hope she isn't
bashful. Don't know
how you got that impression.
