My dearest Billy,

It has been two days that I have not been able to write you, I didn't have anymore lined paper and the stores were closed. Billy darling, I am very worried because since you have left, I have not received any news, what is going on? With mother, Mrs. and Mr. Lodin, we often speak about you and we think that you may not be able to write us. My dearest Billy, I do the same things every day. Now, I swim all day by myself and I go into the open water. I have become very tan. Billy darling, have you been receiving my letters? Maybe this evening at 10 o'clock, I think I may swim with mother, Uncle, and Aunty Lodin. On July 14th, there was a magnificent firework display. I was very hurt to know that you are so far from us. But eventually, I hope to see you again very soon. Billy darling, I feel very sad and very lonely at this moment. Therefore I ask you if you can write me, a long letter to respond to all my letters that I have sent you since the day that you had left. Billy darling, I leave you for today. Mother, Aunty and Uncle Lodin with Lolo send you their best wishes and their deepest regards. Give my best wishes to Bob and for you Billy darling, all of my love and a thousand kisses.
