My Billy dear,

It is with immense joy that I received your gentle letter, in Marseille I am very sad, I feel very lonely despite the 30 soldiers with whom I work and my friend. I ask you Billy darling, to please excuse me if I do not write you often, it is because I do not have a minute to myself. The morning rehearsal at 9 o'clock until noon, the afternoon one from 2 o'clock to 5:30, and at 6 o'clock we leave on a truck to go perform. Billy darling, now I am in uniform (humph!), today I received your letter at the same time as a letter from Aunty, Uncle, and Mother since now she has returned to Nice. In three weeks, we will go perform at the Red Cross in Nice for a week and then for two days in Cannes. Billy darling, I am sending you my address in case you come to Marseille.
