It seems me there is a long time I did not receive any letters of you. Does it mean you are coming back Nice pretty soon? But I saw Andrée yesterday and she told me Tom had written to her. So, Billie, you are a bad boy; but, nevertheless I kiss you for the victory. Hurrah for American, Hurrah for France–
