I thank you very sincerely for the many kindness you have bestowed upon me during my stay in Missoula. I also wish to express my thanks for the farewell party given us before our departure. We travelled all through the trip without any difficulty. We transferred 2 or 3 places and each time we filled ourselves to our stomachs content with good food. At Reno, we transferred to a bus and finally reached our destination. We reached Manzanar 9:45 A.M. Saturday. My family and many friends were at the station to welcome us. The climate here is very different from Missoula. The temperature rises above 100° and is very dry. I like the climate in Missoula much better. I have taken the polished pebbles and stones to Mr. Tsuji, Mrs. F. Minami, and Mr. S. Hamikawa's families. I have also met Mr. Ono's families & brothers. Mr. Inaba's Mr. Marumoto's families and told them about your good health and about your life there. I shall write again about the life at Manzanar.
