Ni-ya Kaz!

I was pleasantly surprised to hear from you. It brings me back swell memories of our Assembly Center wzperiences.

As to our set-up, our "Rec." Department is now called Community Activities. We have four Activities Departments as well as three supporting divisions made up of maintenance, supplies and technical. The four departments are the Adult Recreation, Social Recreation, Athletic Department and Boys and Grils Clubs Activities Department.

In our Clubs Activities, we are divided into two groups--the Boys and the Girls. There are five national organizations and three local. There are 40 paid staff members. The break down is as follows: 11 in the Boy Scouts, 9 in the Boys Club-Y.M.C.A. dual set-up, 4 in the Handicraft, 8 in the Girls Clubs- Y.W.C.A., 5 in the Girl Scouts, 1 in the Campfire Group, 1 departmental secretary and myself. We have over 2,500 active registered membership. The breakdown of the activity is as follows: 325 in the Boy Scouts, 800 in the Boys Clubs-Y.M.C.A., 225 in the Girl Scouts, 700 in the Girls Clubs- Y.W.C.A., 400 in the Handicraft, and 60 in the Campfire. We also have a Community U.S.O. recognized by both the Park Country U.S.O. Chapter and the National. As for the organizational structure of each of these groups each is not only a distinct and independent group, but they are housed under one roof in order that coordination, prevention of duplicity of effort and prevention of competition in the same field might be attained. Hence, mutual aid is encouraged and fostered. We as a department are under Community Activities which in turn is coordinated with Education Department. Mr. Marlin T. Kurtz is the Administrative Director. Mr. Dave Yamakawa is the Assistant Director. I have enclosed a mimeographed chart showing our whole set-up. Detailed from the respective divisional heads. Again, may I state that although scouts and clubs are distinct and independent groups, nevertheless, they coordinated under one head. I'll draw a rough sketch of my department.

Any other information I certainly will be glad to give to you. Incidentally the names of the Divisional Heads are as follows: Dick Fujioka, "Y" General Secretary; John Miyamoto, Boy Scouts District Chairman; George Nishinaka, Coordinator of Boys Clubs; Ben Torigoe, Head of Handicraft; Kiyo Sato, Coordinator of Girls Clubs; Mrs. Amy Nose, "Y.W." Correlator; Kiho Sato, U.S.O. Staff Worker; Mrs. Marilyn Toriye, Girl Scouts Head; Mrs. Fumie Iseria Campfire Supervisor.

Well, let's hear from you. Hope everthing is O.K.
