THESE REGULATIONS ARE MADE FOR THE PROTECTION, CONVENIENCE, AND COMFORT OF ALL MEMBERS OF AREA B. YOUR CONSIDERATION WILL SAVE THE NEXT PERSON FROM POSSIBLE EMBARRASSMENT, TROUBLE OR IMPOSITION. ANY VIOLATIONS SHOULD BE REPORTED IMMEDIATELY, AND UPON REPEATED VIOLATIONS, NECESSARY AND APPROPRIATE POLICE ACTION WILL BE TAKEN.

I. SHOWER ROOM REGULATIONS

- a. No showers after 9:00 P.M.
- b. Emptying of chamber pots and bed pans is strictly prohibited.
- c. Take your towels, soap, toothbrush, clothes, etc. home--Do not leave in shower room.
- d. Washing of dishes, kitchen utensils, or clothing in the shower room is prohibited.
- e. Do not walk on Duck Boards with shoes on.
- f. Do not litter, urinate or spit in the shower room.
- g. Do not move benches or duck boards.

II. REST ROOM OR TOILET REGULATIONS

- a. Tissues must not be taken out of the Rest Room.
- b. Do not spit indiscriminately or litter the toilets with gum, paper, cigarette, tissue papers, etc.
- c. Empty chamber pots and bed pans only in the hole provided for the purpose.

NOTE: Disposal of Sanitary Napkins.

1. Wrap in newspaper provided for that purpose and dispose in can.

III. LAUNDRY ROOM REGULATIONS

- a. Keep clean; do not litter.
- b. Do not dispose of waste under the basin.
- c. Do not waste water or soap and other supplies issued by the camp.
- d. Do not wash dishes in Laundry Room, but only at designated hours in the Mess Halls.
- e. Do not take camp supplies such as Purex, soap, etc., from wash room.

IV. MESS HALL REGULATIONS

- a. Be orderly, eat, and observe the rights of others.
- b. No smoking--no loitering.

V. CURFEW REGULATIONS

- a. All members of the area must be in their rooms by 9:00 P.M.
- b. No loud talking, excessive noise, and blaring radios after 9:00 P.M.
- c. Lights out after 10:00 P.M.

VI. SANITATION NOTICE

- a. Do not throw any debris on the ground.
- b. Be careful of your fruit peelings, candy wrappers, cigarette packages and etc.
- c. Each family should have a waste receptacle of some form in their rooms, and these should be emptied into the garbage cans provided for that purpose. This is everyone's responsibility. It is our benefit and pride to keep this area clean.

- a. Mess Halls and empty rooms may not be used for any purpose without permission--application should be made at the office.
