HINTS FOR BETTER SNAPSHOTS

When you're taking a landscape, be sure to include some subject in the foreground, like a tree or person. This gives depth and reality to the scene.

Try to get pictures of people doing things. Keep them from staring into the camera. The less a picture is posed . . . the better its chances are of being unusually good.

Take standing figures with the camera held vertically; groups and most landscapes with the camera held horizontally.

Hold your camera level. Have subject correctly located in finder. Hold your camera steady. Never make a time or bulb exposure while holding the camera in your hands.
