with all my heart.

Went to see a movie
last nite but it was
n't any too good. The
movie out here is
out in the open out
on the ball diamond.
They have ~~any~~ another
theater out by the
Red Cross and I believe
that one is inside
of a tent. I am going
to the movie tonight
again maybe. It all

depends on the way
I feel.

Today we hauled some
bricks to floor our tent
with and I mashed
my finger. It is all
bandage up and it
bothers me a lot.

It isn't anything serious
so there's nothing to
worry about. The only
trouble is that I can
hardly use my left
hand.

See this place is
sure hot and dusty.
It gets pretty cool
in the evenings
but during the day
it really is something.

Well how in a couple of weeks it will be our anniversary and I regret that I can not be there with you. However how all my thoughts will be of you and will pray that the following one we can spend together.

The 15th. will be our little girls birthday and I hope that my sister has been able to get Aileen her tricycle. I haven't heard from her but I hope that she has gotten the money all alright.

Darling please forget
about the New APO
number I sent you.
Our address will
be 595 Repl. Co. 113th Bu.
APO 761-R. They change
things around here
so much that it really
is hard for me to tell
you anything for sure.
all I know is that
we are going to leave
here again about the
1st of Sept. and it
is suppose to be for
the States but one
never can tell what
may happen from
now till then.

Darling I know that
you are writing to me

3/ regularly but I guess.
I won't be getting any
mail for at least
another week. It happens
that way every time
we move. Now I'll
try my best to write
you as often as I
can but am not
making any promises.
Darling I am sorry
for the unpleasant
letters I ^{have} sent you and
please forgive me.
From here after I'll
not make any more
promises that I
can not keep. I love
you darling and need
you all the time.

Darling I sent you
a hundred dollars to-
day by the way of P.T.A.
I don't know what
that stands for but
since the post office
is some place on
this depot and I
can't find it I
sent it this way. Be-
sides it is the safest
way to send it be-
cause the U.S. Finance
office takes care of
it. Please let me
know when you receive
it my dear. I was
going to send you fifty
more but I'm just
keeping it until the
next time cause I
may need it for some
thing. Hope you don't

mind my dear. How
about the trip to see
my folks, please
~~cancel~~ cancel it un-
til I give you the
okay. Please wait until
the end of October be-
fore you start making
any plans. Thanks.

Dearest I have been
saving all your letters
and aiken's but
just before we moved
I destroyed them all
which I regret now.
I never would have
destroyed them if I
was in my right
mind but that certain
letter got the best of
me which was all my

own fault. I wanted
so much to keep all
them letters and especially
the ones from Aileen. I
had them all filed
away according to the
date they were written.
I hope that you won't
be angry at me now.

Well in the next
days or so some of us
fellies are going to
Florence or at pass.
Heard that there is
nothing there but
it ought to be a
nice trip. Will write
and tell you all
about Florence after
I have visit there.
Am going there to see
some of the fellies of
the 6th Br. now stationed

5/ at the ~~university~~ ^{university}
there. They sure did
get a nice break
cause the 6th Bn are
taking care of the soldiers
going to that school.
Will know I am
going to say good nite.
Will write you soon
again. Please take
the best care of
yourself and Aileen.
