other fellows have
been treating their

Yes how it was

suppose to be a great
guy but I really
know and think that
he is nothing but
a — .

Well I sure hope
that Yuri's ear is
alright. Gee how I
sure do but that
you really do get
disgusted at times.

Well how I went to
the hospital to-day
about my finger
and had an X-ray
taken of it. Sure
hope that it isn't
fractured or some-
thing in that nature.
Well I've got my
finger bandage up

7 in a splint and it
sure does feel lousy.

Today we laid the
floor of our tent with
bricks and it looks
okay now. I don't
know why we are doing
all this because in
a few months we
will be leaving here.
I guess it is just
to keep us doing some-
thing cause it is
bad for us to have
to much idle time.
Doing something like
that is good because
it keeps our minds
occupied and won't
get to homesick.

Well how please
stop worrying and
everything cause things
haven't turned out
the way we expected.
I thought that all
of us in this Co.
would be coming
home soon but it
all went haywire
I guess. Well any-
how it should be
about Sept before
we will know whether
we'll be going home
or what. Things right
now are so undecided
that one never can
tell what may happen
in the next few months.

Darling things around here are very dead and there's nothing to write about. Gee how I sure do wish I knew if we were coming home for sure but I imagine they like to keep us guessing or something. Sure wished that I had about 70 to 80 points my dear so that I edn get out soon. Well at least they will have to let me out some day and I hope that some day will come soon my dear.

Aileen will soon
be three years old
and it should be
just about the time
you'll receive this
letter. I bet she really
is a cute child and
I sure would like to
be with her. I pray
that on her next birth-
day I'll be with her
my dear. Please give
her all my love, hugs,
kisses, and so forth
hon. The same goes
for you on our
anniversary my dear,
even though it isn't
so pleasant as you
would like it to be.
