To-day I am on guard duty. I went on post at 10 this morning and got off at noon. Just had chow so I thought I write you a little cause all my letters lately has been short ones.

I go on duty at 6 P.M. and get off at 8 P.M. and again at 2 A.M. in the morning and off at 4 A.M. There is nothing hard about it and it

seems rather easy but
tiresome.

Well we are going to
move again and believe
me, it really is getting
the best of me. We
are going to a town called
Pistoria or something in
that nature. It is about
30 miles from Florence.
Since I left Rome I
have been seeing a
lot of Italy and I'd
give anything (if I had it)
to be home with you
and Aileen.

Now this 442 has
changed me a great
deal. I have no friends

here as yet and I doubt if I will ever have any. I sure do miss all the fellas from the ole Co 595.

I was there yesterday and most all of the fellas are leaving for the States Monday a few are being assigned over here some place cause they have over 80 points. I believe that they were one of the swellest bunch I ever have been with since I came into the Army.

Now I haven't sent you the money I promised

as yet. If things keep
up the way they are
going now I won't
get a chance to send
it to you. Now if you
don't get any from me
this month then I'll
send you every cent
of my pay next month
which will be two months
pay now. Well now I
know how you are going
to feel cause I have
failed again. Sure hope
that I'll get to send
you some money soon
dear cause I know
that you are going to
need it in the near future.
