Today is Sunday and I slept all morning. It's about 2:00 p.m. now so I thought I'd write you a few lines. Sure hope you have a nice day off and etc.

Well dearest I guess I'd better try to get a furlough even though it is useless cause it'll be the last one. I just found out that a delay enroute counts as a furlough and so it isn't any use asking for one but I am going to try. I'm going to wait until after I get paid payday cause I may not have enough

to buy a ticket with.
Well I am hoping if I'm not sent
out of ~~base~~ here by the 10th
of next month I'm going to
try my darrest to get a furlough.
Well I hope that I can get
one.

See how I really should of
sent in for an extension while
I was there cause the other
fella got one for 5 days and
he just came in to-day.
The third party hasn't come
in as yet. Oh well I'm
going to get a furlough one of
these days if it breaks my
neck.

Well tomorrow will be Monday
again and am sure going to
hate it. Oh well that's life
I guess. Sure pray that
the war will end soon
cause I am sure getting
tired of this life and would
like to come home to you
and Yvri.
