Hello Dear,

Well how are things with you these hot days? How is our little daughter getting along now? Well as for myself I can't say anything much. I really do feel terrible and I sure do wished that I wasn't Alvin E. Uchiyama or something. I am awfully sorry that my letters are all unhappy ones and etc but I just don't feel well. I don't feel a bit hungry and I can't sleep cause everything is worrying me. Well all I can say is that I've done the wrong thing last year and I pray that after this is over all will be well.

Well I moved over to Co. B and am waiting to be shipped out sometime next week to some unit. It sure is a good thing that I don't have to take all this basic training.

How sure do hope that you  
can send me or rather help me  
pay the money so that I can have  
an allotment made out to you.  
I know that it really is a large  
amount but we will loose more  
by letting them take it out of  
my pay. Gee how I sure do want  
to save because you said once  
that we had to save a thousand  
dollars before we can afford to  
have another child. Well how I  
wish you would send me the money  
because than I can make an  
allotment out to you. How I be-  
lieve that after I pay that debt  
that we will be able to save  
a thousand dollars some day.  
Gee how I've had a feeling of  
doing a lot of crazy things but  
I just can't cause I not going  
to do anything that would get  
me in trouble again. How please  
don't worry about me doing anything  
wrong cause I've learned my  
lesson. Gee how hope to hear  
from you real soon.

Well hon my address is still the same except that its Co. B. instead of Company A.

I met a couple of fellows who were in the R.C. with me at Phillips and they only get paid \$10.<sup>00</sup> a month. They owe the Gov. some money and they are paying it out of their pay each month.

See hon I sure pray like hell that you can send me the money real soon by telegram cause it won't reach me in time by a letter cause if I don't get it by Tuesday then I'll have to sign the vouchers. Hon please take a little time off if you have too and try to send it if you can.

Well any hoop if you can't send it by Tuesday or rather if I don't receive it by then then I'll know that you couldn't spare it so I'll just have to have it taken out of my pay. Please don't get angry at me hon cause I was advised that it would be best to pay it up cause we would be losing money if we don't. Besides I was told to tell you cause you would find out if I didn't. Oh well

how I'll wait until Tuesday.

See how I really do feel like hell and I really can't express how I really feel but will tell you when I come on my furlough.

Bawling I love you so darn much and miss you how. Sure wish you were here but that will have to wait until I'm assigned to some unit. How if you can't send me the money I guess you had better wait there until I get my furlough and will get everything straightened out and it would be best for you to go back to your folks cause I won't be able to make any allotment out for you and the baby. See how, wish that you know how I feel and etc.

How did you ever know that Yopoi was married to a Nurse at Sheridan? It really did surprised me when I heard about it this afternoon. Oh well he used to go around with one I know.

Well since I ran out of ink I  
 got to write with a pencil. For  
 please don't get angry or hate me  
 for writing and asking you to  
 help me pay my debt. I really do  
 feel awfully bad hon. Love me  
 hon and please don't stop loving  
 me. I know how you feel and  
 am worried hon. Please say that  
 you love me and that you'll never  
 stop loving me.

Well hon I'm going to close for  
 now and will not write for  
 a few days cause I really do  
 feel like the devil.

Please take the best of care  
 of yourself and your. Be good.  
 Love you with all my heart
