Got our P. X. ration tonight for
the next two weeks. It cost me
about three and a half dollars.
I sure do hate waiting in line
for the stuffs but I needed the
cigarettes and things so I waited.
It took me about an hour or
so. It seems that no matter what
we do around here we always
have to wait in a line. (mile long)

I can assure you that I'll be a
better man. Once I get home
again I'll never leave it. Sure
do hope that I'll be coming
home one of these days soon.

Sure do love and miss you
and little Aileen my love. I
guess Aileen will be a big girl
when I come home. Sure do miss

thing. Take good care of her
and don't let her forget her
daddy. The same goes for you
sweetheart.

Review from Boston. It seems as
though they send me one each
week cause I have been getting
them ever since I came overseas.
I haven't written them and thank
them as yet for sending it to
me so I guess I'd better do it
one of these days soon. They have
some rather interesting news
in it about the boys in France
and elsewhere. It has a little
news of the camp itself but it
mostly has to do about the Y.B.A.
It sure is nice of them to send it to me.
