Sure am happy to hear that every
one is fine. It sure does sounds as
if your getting lazy but you really
do deserve all the rest you can get.
you really are lucky that you can
sleep till seven and that you don't
have to get up. I have to get up at
six a.m. every morning including good
ole Sundays. Train everyday except
Sundays but still have to get up at
6 a.m. but I always go back to bed
about 6:30 a.m. and sleep 1/2 a day on Sun.

3/ We sleep in tents now and we have
cots for bed. It sure does get plenty
cold in here and I would sure enjoy
a nice soft bed. This place is like
Barkley, Beale, and Reynolds only those
places were much nicer. There are a
few Japanese fellas around but I don't
know any of them. Well anyhow now

am kinda helping training the

I received while at the R.C. is
helping me plenty. Sure wish that
I can be on the training staff.

thing in Italian money. Those were only
dimes, nickel, and so forth. I just
wanted you to know what kind of
money we used around here that's
all.

Now I wished that I could get
you and Yuri a lot of things
but I'm in a position where I
can't. It isn't the question of money,
it is simply that I can't find
anything worth while. Identification
bracelets are swell and if I can get
it I will. Now I'm going to send

the next few days so you can get
what you like. o bay?

Darling please do be very careful
when ever your out on a slippery

yourself and that wouldn't be
good. Do be careful and watch
Yuri too.
