Yesterday we got a post card and it says that The city awfully hot and not comfotable as she thought, but try to BENKYOSURU anyway. I think it is a good experience for Julia.

Perhaps you have had about the American Student Party now in this country. The conference recently concluded in Tokyo and the 60 members, including three apanese student one of them is Uchida, are Tyoto and will leave there for Korea and Machukuo in the near future. It is said that the entire group under the leadership of Profs, poth/of/the/pni/wersity/ Francis Bacon and atherine Beers, both of the University of Southern alifornia, chaperons for the group, and accompanied by a half score of apanese delegates, boarded a Keihan liner from the dock in front of the Biwa Hotel where the delegates are quartered, and headed for the famous historical spot of Ishiyama Temple.

Now about the Cabinet, the Yonai Government resigned en bloc
