

Monday eve

Dear Henri -

Thank you very much for Papa's letter, yours, & Helen's
also Dave's postal.

It is very dishonorable of Helen to have
claimed she did a lot of washing for me. She
soaked 4 or 5 at the most, diapers & my ^{white rayon} blouse &
a slip after she did her ^{own} wash. Oh yes, 1 pair wool
sweater of P's. I rinsed ^{after wash.} I call that helping.
and I do not call it a big wash or a lot of
laundry. She did her own all along. She
also bathed, etc without rubber gloves tho she
had them with her. And that was the only
time she did more than a amount of wash.

It is also dishonorable to ask the
assistance of, request help of, and then say
that assistance or effort, if it didn't
turn out to be assistance, was a
hindrance and wrongly timed. We never
offered any advice not asked for.

Please don't ask Papa to speak in your
behalf regards Helen to Yvonne's again.

Ever. I forbid it. I don't call it rushing after 3-4

It makes me very annoyed each time I hear you say this is dirty or that — when I can send over such as the day couch mattress but you don't send measurements requested time & time again — & forbid me to get remuneration for English. Moore has even said Papa would not buy Ichijasu house. You just suggested not to — not us. We have requested your looking at it. Which you haven't done. Which has made me write you request might letter Western Union. So far no ^(write) reply — today is the 3rd day. Why do you make me go out in the snow & do that? It also costs money. Also P has chick fox & Mrs Jijia has to come to stay with her while I am gone.

My lameness has steadily gotten worse & I fell against the stove but was not badly burned. All hot water for

fath and milk — kettle, bucket, coal etc is
carried in as well as coal for stove
by Mr. & Mrs. Sijima. My hemorrhoids are
not worse, shaks groghers — so far.

Mrs. Sato suggests that I hire a
Mrs. Ogata from Block 3 to care for me.
She will ask her if she'll come. She's
doing diaper making for another at present
but baby is now 6 months old & she probably
can be spared.

With you'd be more considerate &
write often, also answer questions.

I would like to remind you to be
a little more discreet than to lay bare
your financial standing to people & tell
about Bath Iron Works, etc etc as it is
all over. Want to remind you that we
owe Schrabacher about \$,500.00 at 6% interest
and don't forget that. Also big expense
coming when I have to get more furniture when
Papa moves with his things — & Martha with
hers — to the newly bought house in J. town.

I will never acquiesce to anyone's using sheets that
belong to the house. They are irreplaceable + not ours anyway!!!

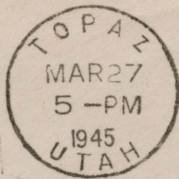
Allen's letter is very enlightening. Haven't heard re: Miesha,
