Kinkakuji, another name Rokuonji, at the foot of Mt. Arashiyama, was built by governor-general Yoshimitsu Ashikaga as his villa about the period of Oyei. Afterwards, it was rendered a Buddhist Temple having the high priest Musokokushi as Archbishop therein. In the garden there is a charming view of thick woods, a spring and the three storied hall covered by gold foil. There is also a tea-etiquette room having alcove-pillars made of nandin.
