harder to absorb.

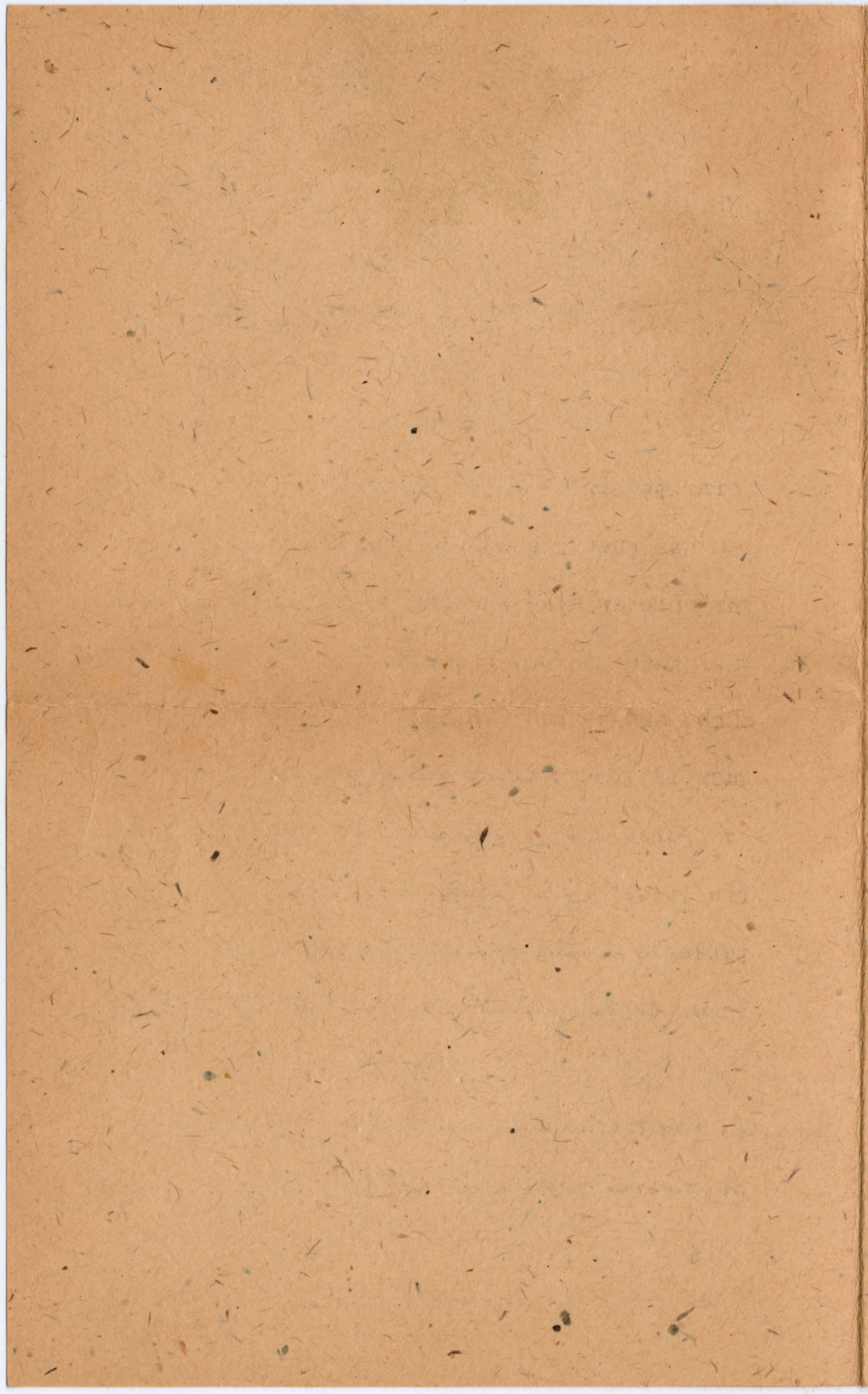
So easy to let everything with pressure behind
