No word on the Reynolds law-suit since my last letter. I guess the Courts are crowded with all kinds of lawsuits at this time and this one will have to await its turn. The woman who brought the suit is now Reynolds wife - he married her last month.

The laundry business is good. Beck and Cochran installed the four new pieces of machinery in the laundry and are using all of yours also - they employ 12 people now and the place is kept very clean.

There are several naughty boys living in the Stanyon St District - about two weeks ago on a windy Sunday Morning they were making a bon-fire in the back of the laundry. Luckily Beck happened to be driving by and had to use the fire extinguisher to put the fire out. - no damage of course but could have been. He reported the matter to the Police and understand these same boys are causing trouble in the whole neighborhood.

I received your card two weeks ago. This card was dated March 6 and the Topaz post mark shows a date of April 6.

No word received as yet regarding the reference mentioned in your card. - will be glad to answer favorably.

It will not be necessary for you to be represented in court because the suit is between Reynolds and Beck. I will be called as a witness for Beck and if Reynolds should by any chance get a judgment against Beck I will immediately attach any money awarded to Reynolds and apply same on your rent and other amounts owing you by the Beck Reynolds Partnership.

This is all the news so with best wishes to all of you.
