*Material: chipwood stitched (suggested)*

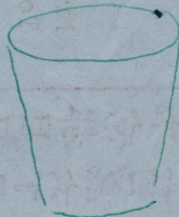
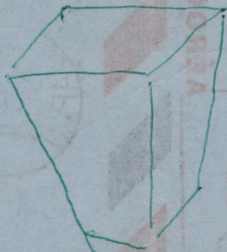
TECHNIQUE: Okayama machine stitched straw hat-type waste baskets.

- 1) Shape: round, square, or oval.
- 2) Must be tapered for stackability, to save cubic for shipping.
- 3) Colors: TTCO colors of MAT-32 and MAT-1913.
- 4) Clear colorless plastic coating both inside and outside of straw surface would be new approach for better product, higher standard, longer practicality.
- 5) Small first quantity for our own 3 retail stores.
