We went back to the warehouse after dinner to finish our work in pasting the papers....K learned to do this by helping Aki that last few days she did it, and I recall from 2-3 yrs. back and we both did and finished, by two trips there (one in the afternoon and one after dinner) 120.00 worth to one customer, whose order I took by tele phone.

At 9:15 when I came home, Norma was with Richard and told me. Pinkie came home soon afterwards.

P baked this afternoon, and Sakurai went fishing with the Sawanoboris and Jiro. I think we should move away to 36th as soon as possible, and take him into our family doings. He's lonely bec. he can't understand English as well as Katchan and he feels left out except in a J. speaking home. Also he loves fishing. Masaji loves fishing so they can do it together. I'm spending as much time as possible with K and children, so they can talk to me their problems.

Gave K partial control of the steering wheel on the way to and from warehouse as his first driving lesson. He is nervous, but feeling happy. He is torn between wanting to be near girls and J speaking people, and loyalty to me, so I want to do everything possible the short time I'm here. I'll be going to Chicago Thursday night, arr. Fri AM. Please inform me when you expect to leave for SF.

I gather that the Show was so terrific the 1st day that you're running out of order forms. If you do, just buy some from Brock's and Brentano's across the street on the La Salle side. What good news.
