



8:30 am

(2) Ordered some tabatai - 8-10 shades 1 pc each of some colors which I'll choose to when I get samples of organdie dye

(3) Got  made noid - cordie (5pc) and mandarin coat (7pc) down front labor = 43 up from  kind - cheap, eh? Small extra charge for extra material.

3/9:30 Mrs. Sugi-hara of Serizawa's office came + we talked till 11:30.

4/11:00 Suzuki came + we decided to "case the comi" for ideas in his ear.
