bankers coats: 6 each. SML sizes, each of six colors, " 108 pc.

(They also ordered the raw silk kimonos, 100 pc. in red only, but we have these on order)

We cabled for swatches of colors they have immediate stock of so we can select colors from them to speed up production, that is if they have any stock at all. Personally, I think their answer means they don't have any raw silk of this kind in stock and they have to be woven. If that's the case and they mean that they can still weave and ship the garments in October, we want the above Gump's selections because they are already sold. Our original cable asking them to stop making the long kimonos in the blue and red was before we got the Gump's order and we wanted them to how soon they can send additional order for coolie jackets and bankers coats, but they answered that they can't ship until November. Then we cabled about sending us the swatches of material on hand and our latest cable from Kamei is the one I quoted above. I hope this is clear. (so many interruptions). Well the crux of the matter is, we do want raw silk soolie jackets and bankers coats as soon as possible in the colors we mention above. We need the raw silk kimonos also, and we intend to continue with them also. We received sample of a duster yesterday or day before in red, but I think dusters are a little out of style at present, anyway, why try to get that when Kamei can't supply the ones on order now? So we will not even think about any other style right now. In the future, they must enclose copy of the prices with the sample garments they send because the customs people are very fussy and we usually get the sample a day or two before their letter 11 and price sheet.

We received samples of Fuji silk pink and grey blue kimono yesterday-prices arrived today. The light blue one is a little too greyish, didn't you think? We are out of all pongee kimonos now except for the brown and charcoal.
We have some big back-orders on them now. They must ship the natural, red, blue and pongee on order immediately unless they already have (they said they would ship on September 10th) We ordered on July 19th and we haven't heard a peep from them until you got to Janes. We have no documents that they have

ahipped anything, including the zabuton covers. We got the samples of the zabuton covers. They are not exactly what we ordered as far as colors, that is some with same code as last years' is a different color. One happy error was DZ-30, which is a new one, a pink-orange and it's rather nice. Red, bright red, seems very popular and unfortunately we don't have too many bright colors. 2. Re: Ichikawa: do you think they can fill our orders this year? We have an awful lot of lighters on order and we have a lot of them sold and must deliver. We have to get most of them in here by early November to ship to our customers to reach them by end of November and as you know it sometimes takes two weeks to reach the east coast. This means the Ichikawa people will have to do a lot of shipping between now and end of October. If we go into other lighters, it's probably better to get them from another source so as not overburden one firm. we got the 9 X 12 goza harlequin design grass floor mat and it looks good.

We need the HB-50 walnut shaped wind bells. Will Kato ship soon? He says he is shipping some things to arrive here on 29th but they aren't on it.

The office is becoming a regular mad house now.
