cheaply with his permission and sold cheaply as wrapping  
papers, cards, etc. at rock bottom prices - as I had planned  
last year.

which I shall not buy and one container (logquered)  
which I shall not buy due to chipping.

The small retail store stems I shall purchase  
after my tour to KANSAI for I do not actually leave  
any time.

New items do take so much discussion & planning.  
I am having HASK take out Jap. patent on that ring puzzle  
toy and he will make it for me. We plan to market it  
in Japan also <sup>from</sup> which we shall get a small commission.  
DICKAI has interesting teak salad servers (14"  @ \$4.40  
FOB) which are very nice. We is working on salt/rubber ut, candle  
holders, salad bowls, teak key chains etc. Please price DICKAI  
candle bowl for me at retail. Japan's prices may not be  
competitive. But we should have our share of the market.  
We must have a varied & wider selection to sell.

I have made quite a few plans and I do hope  
they come to fruition this summer.
