Dear Mr. Hagiwara,

I am reminding you that you owe me some money which I left in your care in Tokyo, from my personal funds. It was, according to my records, a stack of Japanese Yen equal in US Dollars to \$156.00. You teld me yourself that you had spent it, but that you would repay me. You promised me payment when I mentioned it again in 1957 when you were talking to me.

Enough time has now elapsed and I must have this debt cleared immediately. I have heard of your plans for departure to Japan in the near future.

Therefore, I request full payment, without interest, to be made by February 5th to reach my attorney, Mr. Victor Abe. Mr. Abe's address is:

Mr. Victor Abe, Attorney at Law Purcell, Riordan and Abe, Attys. 990 Geary Street San Francisco, California.

You are also in possession of certain papers, documents, files, copies of letters, and originals of letters (such as one addressed to me personally in Tokyo from the law firm of Lowenthal and Lowenthal of San Francisco regarding Japanese inheritance tax on my father's estate), other memes, memo books, receipts, address books pertaining to business of the Takanshi Trading Company either purchased by yourself or from my personal funds, or using funds of the Company withedrawn from the Takahashi Trading Company Savings Account with the Sumitomo Bank of Marunouchi, Tokyo for which you held the only Passbook and withdrawal seal hled legal in Japan.

You are also in possession and have withheld this same seal which I have repeatedly requested the return, toghether with the Passbook. I have recovered the Passbook in September of 1958 in Japan, but still require the Seal. I was shocked at the meagerness of the remaining balance in the account.

These aforementioned items, and all such other papers, equipment, tools, office supplies, and accourrements of business as were gathered or acquired or otherwise come into your possession in regards contacts

As the original Sponsor of the aforementioned

Katsuhiko Hagiwara

which enabled him to come to the United States, I feel it my responsibility to report that he was dismissed from my Company by the undersigned because his performance was unsatisfactory.

At the time of his departure, he withheld from myself and my Company various Company records consisting of addresses and mames of sources in Japan in connection with my business. These were all acquired either by myself or by him, after his connection with my Company, before which time he was a full time student. At all times he was solely in my employ, and not in any other, being supported solely by myself during the last period of his University carreer in exchange for his service as apprentice in my business.

As my copy of the letter I wrote to him dated today states, and I enclose same, I am asking him for the return of my money (personal) which I entrusted in his care and which he admittedly spent and which he promised me he would make good; and other items of personal nature in and about his person his room, and his accountrements which he has retained, borrowed, or has for one or another reason retained or happens to have.

Also, upon my investigation conducted by myself in my trip to Japan during September-October 1958, I discovered serious shortages of Company funds withdrawn by himself upon a Savings account belonging to the Comany, and have also talked to numerous persons both among his immediate relatives and his acquaintances made through my business who were lavishey wined and dined at restaurants and bars in a manner not suited to a young man on a supposed salary-type income. All this and also actual facts of the almost complete depletion of adequate funds in Takahashi Trading Company Savings Account

in the Marunouchi Branch of the Sumitomo Bank, Tokyo, Japan, the Passbook to which he withheld, but which was recovered by myself after tracing down several falsehoods stated by Mr. Hagiwara regarding its whereabouts. This recovery was not through Mr. Hagiwara.

He still has not returned the Legal Seal which in Japanese Banking Law, allows the possessor to make withdrawal of funds; nor has he made any efforts to do so.

I have instructed Mr. Victor Abe, attorney with Purcell, Rhordan and Abe of 990 Geary Street, San Francisco, to proceed with legal action as my Agent, to assist me in the return of my money in the sum of \$56.00 without interest. This is the equivalent of the apanese Yen currency which my r cords show I handed to him in a taxbab en route to the Airport the night of my departure from Tokyo to come back to the States. At this time, I wish the return of the records of business to their rightful place, which is my possession.

The strange manipulations or discrepancies in the Company funds and where Mr. Hagiwara might have gotten the funds for his lavish social gestures and expenditures is a separate matter for another reckening and consideration as well as conjecture.

As initaal Sponsor of Mr. Hagiwara's entry to the United States I am making a statement of what I believe to be fact.


