April 15, 1958 Letter #12 Dear Henri:

Since you are not in Tokyo now, we are sending the p.o. for the 72" beach parasols and the selection of colors on the balance of the 36" parasols directly to Kagawaken's Mr. Hirai to save time. Gump's ordered 48 half and half, 12-blue/green, 12 blue/white, 12 pink/red, 12 black/white; 48 Kotobuki: 12 blue, 12 persimmon, 12 white, 12 black 48 spirals, 12 blue/green, 12 red/white, 12 blue/white, 12 pink/red.

Our order to Hirai for 72" is 50 doz., eliminated all black solid, and changed some proportions by increasing on those we felt more popular.
