SPONSORSHIP OF ALIENS FOR ENTRY INTO THE UNITED STATES

A person who desires to sponsor the admission of an alien into the United States should supply an affidavit in duplicate setting forth the sponsor's financial ability and willingness to contribute to the alien's support. Both copies must be sworn to, before a Notary Public in the United States or before an American Consular officer abroad. There is no prescribed form for such affidavits and the following example is given merely for the information and convenience of sponsors:

Affidavit of Support

I, _____, being duly sworn, depose and say:

1. That I am a native of _____ and _____ years of age, and have been a legal resident of the United States for the past _____ years. My present residence is at _____ (give full address) and my permanent mailing address is _____;

2. That I am an American citizen by birth and have always maintained my citizenship. (If sponsor has been naturalized, give instead date and place of naturalization and number of naturalization certificate. If not a citizen, give date and place of legal entry into the United States for permanent residence and date and place of making declaration of intention.);

3. That I am _____ (state whether single, married, widowed, or divorced. If married, this affidavit should either be in joint-affidavit form or the following phrase should be added to this paragraph: " and that my wife has read and concurs in this affidavit, as evidenced by her signature hereinafter subscribed");

4. That the following are the only persons dependent in any way upon me for support: (give full name each, age, relationship to you and, if only partially dependent, the degree of your responsibility):

5. (Here give full details concerning your employment or business, specifying annual earnings or income at least to the extent necessary to indicate your ability to fulfil the obligation assumed by this affidavit.);

6. (Here give full details concerning your net worth, specifying to the extent necessary: amount of cash, when and where deposited: value of real estate owned and, if encumbered, to what extent; value of personal property, investments, life insurance, etc);

7. That I am the _____ (state relationship, whether of blood, friendship, business or other nature) of _____ (give full name of person being sponsored), who now resides at _____ (give full address) and desires to enter the United States for permanent residence (If not for permanent residence, state exact purpose for which entry into the United States is desired and the approximate length of stay);

8. (Here state exact terms of guarantee. If for permanent residence: "That I hereby solemnly swear that I will receive and care for him and will at no time allow him to become a charge of the United States, or of any State, territory or subdivision thereof", If for temporary stay: "That I guarantee, without reservation, his maintenance and welfare, including defrayment of all incidental expenses, requisite travel and medical expenses incurred by him while in the United States, and I further guarantee his departure from the United States before the expiration of his authorized stay". If sponsor does not assume full responsibility, the wording of the foregoing phrases should be altered to show exactly and in detail the extent of the sponsor's obligation.");

9. (If guarantee includes payment of passage: "That I can and will pay the cost of his transportation and incidental expenses from _____ to _____, his final destination in the United States". Unless the alien is coming for permanent residence, the following should be added: "and I further guarantee the payment of his transportation from the United States for _____ upon the completion of his stay in the United States".);

10. That I freely incur the obligations involved in this affidavit because _____ (state reasons in detail):

11. That I have given similar affidavits of support on behalf of the following named persons during the past five years: 66

12. That I make this affidavit for the purpose of inducing United States consular and immigration authorities to issue him a visa and admit him into the United States.

I In addition to two copies of an affidavit of support, the sponsor must also supply evidence, likewise in duplicate, of his

1. Affidavits from an officer of a bank giving date upon which sponsor's account was opened, itemized statement of deposits for past year, and the present balance.
2. Affidavits from employer showing nature of sponsor's employment, annual salary, how long employed, and whether employment is temporary or permanent.
3. Reports of a commercial rating concern regarding sponsor or his business.
4. Certified copies of the latest income tax return.
5. Other evidences of net worth as claimed in the affidavit.

The affidavits and all evidence of financial ability should be sent in duplicate directly to the alien, who will present same to the nearest American Consulate. When the visa is granted, one set of the documents will be returned to the alien for presentation to the Immigration authorities at his port of arrival in the United States.

Evidence furnished by a sponsor usually is sent to the

Evidence furnished by a sponsor usually is sent to the intending immigrant in order that he may have it available for presentation to the consular officer when he is requested to submit his support documents for examination. However, the evidence may be sent direct to the consular office by the sponsor if the sponsor prefers. Evidence so submitted will be considered confidential if requested by the sponsor.
