We will look forward to seeing and hearing you again in the not too distant future; meanwhile, thank you for being with us.

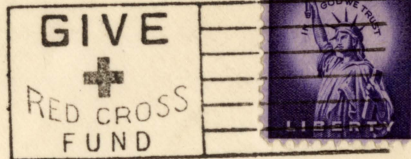
