We've been here since Sunday night and staying with friends in a new apartment building in a new housing area. I've never seen anything so wonderful. The shopping center puts Stoneham to shame. They have super markets just like home only even better and cleaner. There are thousands of wonderful stores like Fraser's. In fact, so many that it is really frustrating to shop. We bought so much that our little car is just about bursting. We leave for Denmark tomorrow and look forward to Copenhagen where we will probably see more things to buy. We bought several lamp shades to show you. Will went to Helsinki yesterday + said it was terrific. I didn't go because it costs so much + we felt Will should go alone. We spent ~~one~~ <sup>two</sup> days in Oslo. It was a beautiful city

and not as cosmopolitan as Stockholm.  
It was very inexpensive and the food was  
very good. The food here is really wonderful  
too. The restaurants are reasonable and  
very clean. The coffee is delicious too.  
It's everything England isn't.

We plan to stay in Copenhagen  
for three days — until next Wednesday  
and then we cross over to Germany and  
drive through Hamburg, Cologne and  
across Belgium to Brussels and across  
the channel to Dover on Oct. 1st.

Our friend here is a Danish  
architect we met when Bill was at  
Lafeway. He is working here and  
says it's wonderful here because there  
is so much building going on.
