To Star Light Laundry

Dear Sir:

Your attention is hereby called to the following Resolution of the Board of Supervisors of the City and County of San Francisco:

RESOLUTION NO. 2444. (New Series.)

RESOLVED, THAT THE STAR Light Laundry be and is hereby granted permission, revocable at will of the Board of Supervisors, to erect and maintain a boiler of 20 horse power, in premises situate at No. 750 Stanyan street, to substitute one of 8 horse power heretofore installed in said premises, the same to be used for laundry purposes.

Provided said boiler shall be erected to the satisfaction and under the supervision of the Board of Public Works and of the Chief Engineer of the Fire Department, and that a certificate of inspection shall be furnished by some competent inspector of boilers that said boiler is safe, which certificate shall specify the test to which said boiler was subjected.

(Petitioned for March 23, 1908.)

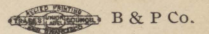

Your attention is hereby called to the following Ordinance passed by the Board of Supervisors

RESOLUTION NO. 239. (New Series.)

RESOLVED, THAT STARLIGHT Laundry be and is hereby granted permission, during the pleasure of the Board of Supervisors, to erect and maintain an engine and boiler of eight (8) horsepower in premises situate at No. 750 Stanyan Street, to be used for laundry purposes.

Provided that said engine and boiler shall be erected to the satisfaction and under the supervision of the Chief Engineer of the Fire Department and of the Board of Public Works, and that a certificate of inspection shall be furnished by some competent inspector of boilers that said boiler is safe, which certificate shall specify the test to which said boiler has been subjected.
