CONTRIBUTION IS DUE AND PAYABLE ON MAY 15, 1937, AND DELINQUENT JUNE 15, 1937. If remittance is not postmarked before midnight of June 15, 1937, interest charges of 12 per cent per annum must be assessed under the law. The Act contains no provision for waiver of interest.
